South America: Countries

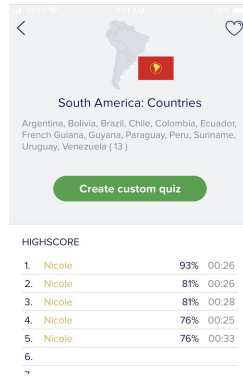
