Institutional Aid Refund Policy

Institutional aid is refunded based upon withdrawal date and follows the procedures set forth in the Refund Schedule. In addition, Institutional scholarships are deemed to have been applied to a student's account following credits to the account from all other sources of student funding.

If a credit (refund) balance exists to the student account upon the successful completion of enrollment requirements, graduation, or withdrawal from Fisher College for any other reason, the student has one calendar year from the date of separation to apply for a student refund that has been generated from, or includes, Institutional funds.

After one calendar year, Fisher College reserves the right to retract the Institutional scholarships deemed to have created the credit balance.
