Classroom Vermicompost Kit

Seedleaf will provide an indoor vermicompost system equipped with worms, start-up bedding and an informational sheet on basic worm and bin care. Seedleaf's education and outreach coordinator will make (1) trip to classrooms who purchase bins to provide a presentation on vermicomposting to students.

School Garden Bed Construction

Seedleaf will install a basic school garden that consists of (3) 8'x3'raised beds filled with a blend of topsoil and compost. Beds are constructed from 2' x 12' Cedar boards.

[Additionally, school staff must follow FCPS Outdoor Classroom Manual protocols, to include Needs Assessments, forming an Outdoor Classroom Team and hosting an initial OC Team meeting. Garden Club Support
