

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA – Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II) Information Report - FINAL report student portion

1. Mid-East Career and Technology Centers – Adult Education funding from the **Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021** to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The total funds the institution received was \$490,347 under Section 314(a)(1)
3. PART 1 – Student Portion
 - a. Of the portion above \$181,207 had to be disbursed to students.PART 2 – Institution Portion
 - a. The Institution portion is \$309,140
4. We distributed \$10,500 to students in the current Heavy Equipment Operator class on 2/19/2021. We will also disburse \$170,760 to the rest of our students in our Title IV eligible programs on 4/16/2021. This will expend the full \$181,207 for the student portion in full and used a small portion of the institution portion also.
5. The total estimated number of student that are eligible to participate in is 128 students.
6. The total number that have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant as of 4/16/2021 will be 128.
7. Mid-East CTC – Adult Education used an application process to determine need using the Cost of Attendance by program and also the EFC to determine needs. Students had to fill out a short application indicating a need for the funds. They were also given the choice to apply it to their account and how much to apply.
8. Students were told in the application where the grants were coming from, what they were for, how to apply, and the deadline for the application.
