

Personal Items of Value and Cell Phone Policy and Rules

Lindsey Academy staff strongly recommends that students not bring electronic devices (cell phones, tablets, gaming devices, etc.) or personal items of value (jewelry, money, etc.) to school since loss, theft or damage is possible. These items can also be distracting to the educational process and may be confiscated by school personnel if they affect the learning process.

If students choose to bring electronic devices or personal items of value to school, they must be put away, not seen, and electronics must be powered off.

If items of value or electronic devices are damaged or stolen, students and parents are responsible for the damage or loss. Lindsey Academy is not responsible for these items and no searches will be conducted.

All electronic devices* must be **powered off** and put away while on campus. Phones on 'vibrate/silent' mode are not powered off.

Absolutely no electronic devices* should be used once students are on campus, including before start of class, during class time, and passing periods.

Electronic devices* may not be used at any time during lunch, in restrooms, or PE locker room area.

Earbuds or earphones must be out of sight and put away –not hanging around neck/collar or placed in your ear.

Cell phone/electronic devices in use during the school day or while on campus will be confiscated and turned in to the office.

If cell phones ring or are in sight, they will be confiscated and returned only to a parent/guardian listed on the student's emergency card.

Failure to comply with school staff requests for cell phones or electronic devices* shall result in further disciplinary action.

Photographing, videotaping, or otherwise recording individuals while on campus is strictly prohibited.

*Electronic devices include, but are not limited to, cell phones, electronic game systems, toys, wireless earbuds, earphones, tablets and laptop computers.
