

Scholar Expectations

One-Liners

These phrases express specific expectations for scholars to follow:

- ❖ Walk & Talk – Keep the conversation moving
- ❖ Catch & Release – PDA Hug and Go
- ❖ Put Earphones away – Take them off and put them away
- ❖ Put It Away (Cell Phone) – Turn it off and put it away
- ❖ Hood Off / Hat Off – Honor the dress code
- ❖ Language Check – No profanity - keep it clean

Before School

- Have your ID ready to show.
- Wear only approved uniform attire.
- No hoodies or hats on.
- Cell phones must be powered off and put away.
- Earphones/earbuds must be put away.
- Follow directions from adults respectfully.
- You must have teacher permission to enter a hallway.
- Use the restroom prior to entering class.
- No gum, glass containers, skateboards, scooters, weapons / weapon lookalikes are allowed on campus.

After School

- Only students in a supervised club or after school activity are allowed to remain on campus after school.
- All other students must leave campus immediately after school; no loitering.
- Cell phones are to be used off campus only to avoid item being confiscated for not following school cell phone rules.
- Walk in designated crosswalks.
- Be respectful of neighbors and their property.
- Do not litter and / or damage school and neighboring property.

Passing Periods

- Walk at all times.
- Walk on the right side in the hallways and stairs.
- No more than two side-by-side and in single file if sidewalks are narrow.
- Keep your hands and feet to yourself.

Restroom

- Use the restroom before and after class, during passing period and at lunch.
- A restroom pass is needed if using the restroom during class (restroom emergencies only).
- Restroom breaks are not allowed 10 minutes before or after the bell rings.
- Follow restroom etiquette -GO, FLUSH, WASH, LEAVE.
- No cell phone use is allowed in restrooms.
- Respect the privacy of others.
- Report any problems to an adult immediately.

Assembly/ Auditorium

- Follow teacher's directions in the classroom.
- Stay in your assigned seat.
- Sit up straight and give full attention to the program.
- Applaud appropriately and at the right times.
- Remain seated quietly until teacher directs dismissal.
- Follow directions of all supervising adults before, during, and after assembly.

Scholar Expectations

Lunch Period

- Walk to the lunch lines.
- Walk on the right side of the walkways.
- When approaching the food lines, go to the end of the line.
- Wait in single file lines – no cutting is allowed.
- Show respect toward all adults and students while waiting in line.
- No eating in line for safety reasons.

Cafeteria

- Be ready with your ID and / or PIN number.
- Politely place your food order, say please and thank you.
- Carefully carry your food tray to your seat, show proper table manners, clean up after yourself and throw away your trash.
- Exit cafeteria through the west door, toward the quad area.

Cafeteria Windows

- Be prepared with your ID and / or PIN number.
- Politely place your food order, say please and thank you.
- Carefully carry your food tray to your seat, show proper table manners when eating, clean up after yourself and throw away your trash.
- Leave eating area clean.

Designated Eating Areas

- Food must be eaten only in the designated eating areas.
- Food may not be carried across the blacktop – food obtained in the cafeteria must be eaten at the North Benches AND food obtained at the windows must be eaten at the South Benches.
- No walking around while eating allowed.
- Sit in the marked areas at the North and South benches and on the lawn.
- No eating along the bungalow ramps or the side of the buildings.

Quad / Benches

- Be safe and do not stand or run on the benches.
- Do not sit on top of the tables.
- Once you have received your food, move to the quad/bench area.
- The lunch area is for eating and visiting quietly.
- Do not play with or throw food.
- Do not take food from others.
- Keep eating area clean and place trash in the trash cans.

West Field

- ID is required to enter and check out equipment.
- No Temporary IDs are allowed.
- Place backpacks along the fence.
- Follow directions when announcement to return equipment and collect backpacks is made.
- No food, gum or candy of any kind allowed.
- No drinks other than water are allowed.
- Do not hang from or pull on basketball hoops, nets or volleyball nets. No sitting on tennis nets.
