Honors 7th Grade Introduction to Spanish

1 semester | .5 credit

In Honors 7th Grade Introduction to Spanish, students practice communicating in three ways: (1) by interpreting written and spoken language, (2) by communicating with other people, and (3) by giving or listening to presentations. Students become good communicators by practicing the language skills of reading, writing, speaking, and listening. While students are practicing communicating, they are also learning about the customs and cultures of Spanish-speaking peoples and nations, which both helps them better understand their own culture and customs and helps them understand how some Spanish speaking people live. Students will be challenged to push themselves academically, think creatively, and develop a deeper understanding of the Spanish language. Students who successfully complete this course will be communicating at the novice-low level in each of the reading, writing, speaking and listening skills, and will be prepared for Pre-AP Spanish I.

Pre-AP Spanish I

2 semesters | 1 credit

In Pre-AP Spanish I, students practice communicating in three ways: (1) by interpreting written and spoken language, (2) by communicating with other people, and (3) by giving or listening to presentations. Students become good communicators by practicing the language skills of reading, writing, speaking, and listening. While students are practicing communicating, they are also learning about the customs and cultures of Spanish-speaking peoples and nations, which both helps them better understand their own culture and customs and helps them understand how some Spanish speaking people live. In Pre-AP Spanish I, students advance their student of Spanish language and culture, and will be challenged to push themselves academically, think creatively, and develop a deeper understanding of the Spanish language. Students who successfully complete this course will be communicating at the novice-mid level in each of the reading, writing, speaking and listening skills, and will be prepared for Pre-AP Spanish II.
