 - ▶ To register for the ACT test you will need:
 - ▶ computer with internet
 - ▶ credit card or other payment
 - ▶ high school course information
 - ▶ headshot photo

 - ▶ Consider choosing a test date at least two months ahead of the application deadlines of all the colleges and scholarship agencies you might want to apply to.
 - ▶ Multiple-choice scores are normally reported within 2–8 weeks after the test date. If you take the ACT with writing, scores will be reported only after all of your scores are available, including writing, normally within 5–8 weeks after the test date.

- Unconditional Acceptance to TN schools

- Guaranteed HOPE Scholarship regardless of GPA
- \$20,400 over 4 years (4.5k/year - Fr./So., \$5.7k/year - Jr./Sr.)

- Next Tier of HOPE scholarship, beginning academic scholarships
- \$24,400 over 4 years (\$500 extra each semester)

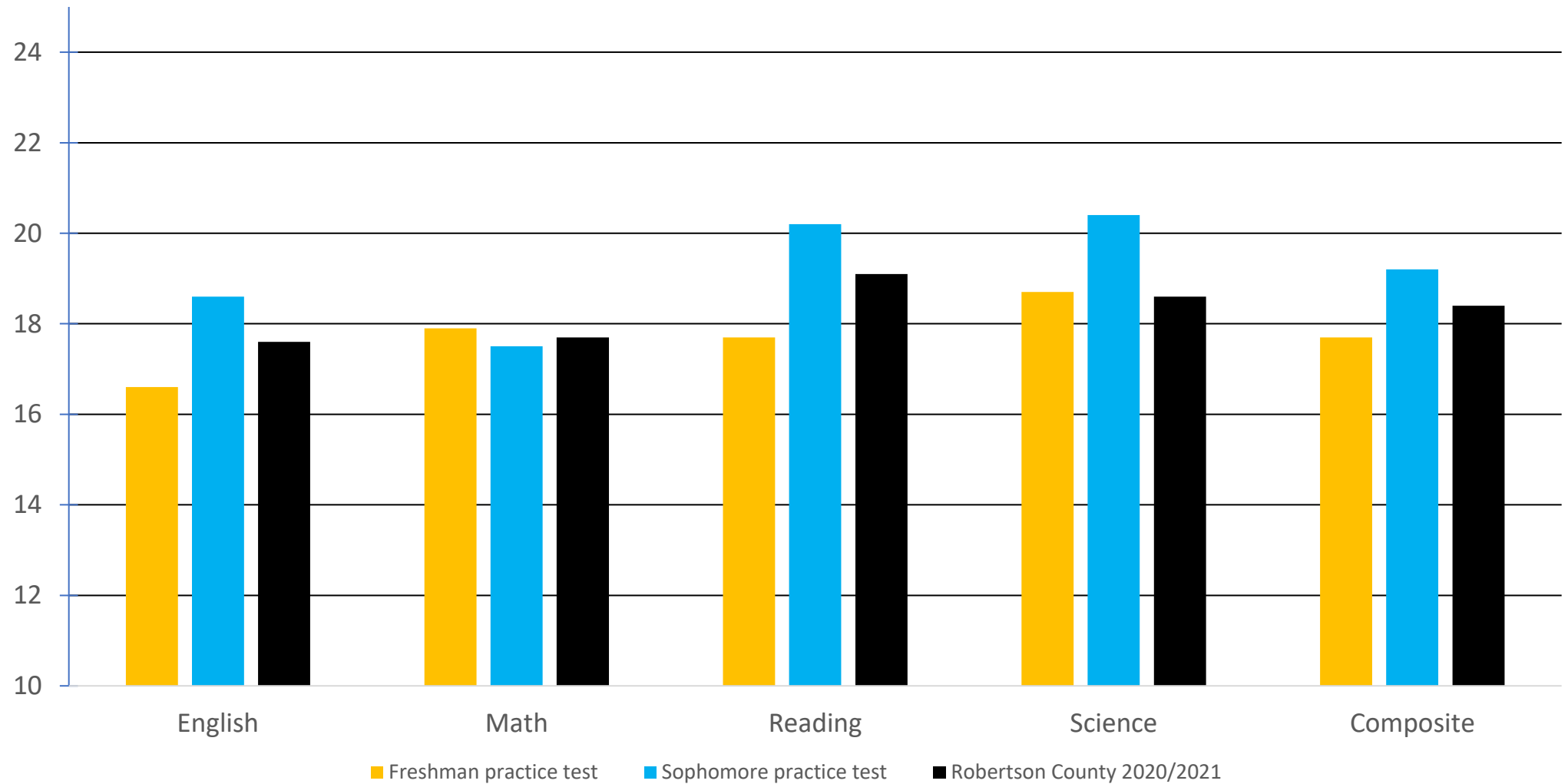

- ▶ +7 → National avg. growth over 4 years

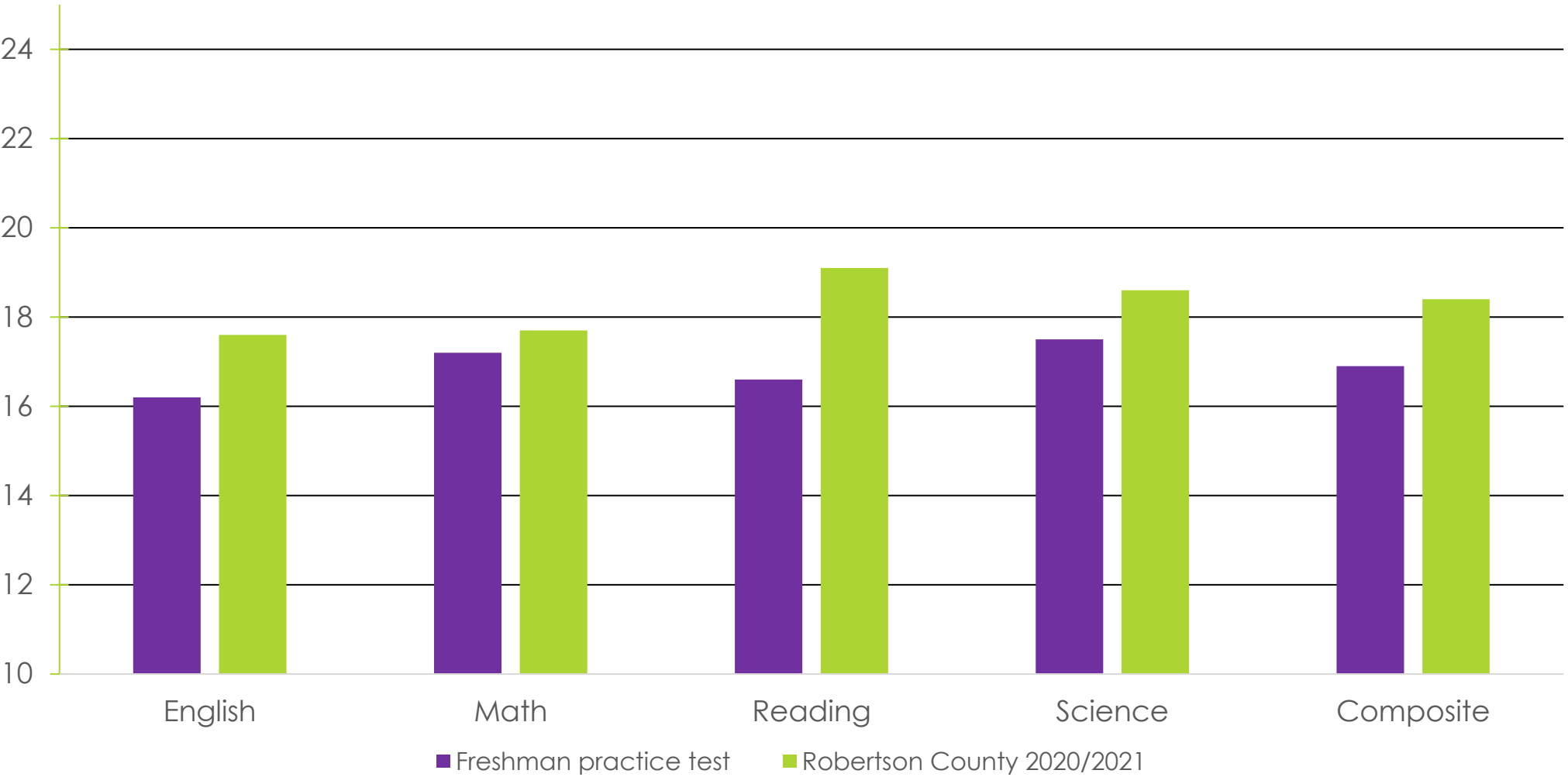
