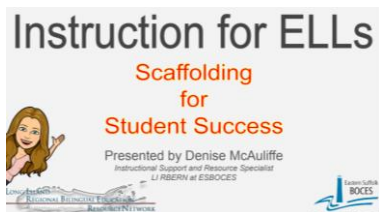


Asynchronous Learning Opportunities

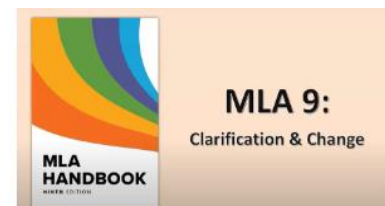
Participants will explore how to scaffold all parts of a lesson including introducing a lesson, building background knowledge, and supporting vocabulary development.
