

## **HOW DO I REGISTER?**

### Step 1

Call the District Registrar (608) 845-4360 to make an appointment. Bring: proof of residency (current utility bill, lease or mortgage document) and child's birth certificate.

## Step 2

Wait to be sent your unique snapcode and further instructions. (Sent only if you did step 1). Placement follows the order registration is received. Legacy families MUST complete step 2 by March 1 to secure legacy space.

### Step 3

Your child will be placed at a Pre-K site. In June your family will be notified which site your child will attend.





## WHAT IS FAMILY ENGAGEMENT?

The Pre-K program has a strong focus on family-school communication with regular family engagement workshops, activities, events and concerts.

## WHO ARE THE TEACHERS?

The Pre-K teachers are highly qualified Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction licensed teachers. A co-teacher is assigned to classrooms of more than 12 students.

# **ABOUT VERONA AREA** PRE-K ....

Verona Area Pre-K is a community based preschool program for four year old children residing within the Verona Area School District.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR VERONA $\Delta RF \Delta PRF - K?$

Any four-year old living within the Verona Area School District on or before September 1st.

#### WHAT IS THE COST?

This is a tuition-free program. A fee may be charged for supplies, fieldtrips, and/or snacks. Some locations offer optional extended childcare. Families are responsible for childcare cost beyond the Pre-K hours. Families must arrange childcare on a first-come, first-serve basis.



#### WHERE WILL MY CHILD ATTEND?


Students are taught in local community preschool or childcare locations. Families list their 1st. 2nd. and 3rd preferences when they register online.

#### WHAT WILL MY CHILD LEARN?

Children will participate in playbased activities that provide rich learning experiences. A focus on learning through play allows children to gain skills in all areas including: socialemotional, cognitive, creative expression, early literacy, early math, and self-help. Teachers will use materials and curriculum that enhance those experiences through a handson approach.

#### WHEN ARE THE CLASSES?

Classes run Tuesday through Friday for 3 hours and 10 minutes daily, following the Verona Area School District calendar.

#### WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE **TRANSPORTATION?**

Families needing transportation services anytime during the year will be limited to picking a Pre-K site within their neiahborhood zone.

Transportation will be provided if the child lives or is cared for 1/4 mile or more from the Pre-K site in the neighborhood zone.

Pick up and drop off will be close to the residence but busses will not go down culde-sacs and dead end roads.

Families participating in the Spanish Bilingual Program will be transported districtwide.
