# WEB PROGRAM

## A student organization that:

- Enables 8th grade student leaders and mentors to make a difference on our campus all year long
- Helps 6<sup>th</sup> graders transition to Middle School
- Helps promote positivity
- Welcomes new Middle School students on to campus throughout the year



# What does a WEB leader do?<sup>c</sup>

- Leads 6th grade orientation
- Runs and prepares 6th grade Social Emotional activities during advisory typically 2x a month
- Peer tutoring for 6th grade students
- Welcomes new students
- Maintains positive and meaningful connections throughout the school year



# 6th Grade Orientation

- Occurs the day before school starts
- Whole group assembly
- 6th grade students have the opportunity to meet their WEB Leader for activities and school tour!
- Not a registrar event, only orientation. Students will get schedules and ipad/books the week before.

# WEB Wednesdays

- WEB leaders will be assigned specific 6th grade Advisory classes for the duration of the year
- Everytime an Advisory period lands on a Wednesday, WEB leaders will go into classes and lead activities
- Sample Session: Interactive activities, written or verbal reflections
- Focused around SEL Competencies



# WEB Wednesdays

- The role of the teacher leaders (Krystal and Christine) will make sure the 8th grade students are prepared for each lesson.
- All WEB leaders will be assigned to one Advisory class with Krystal.



# Peer Tutoring

- Monthly Mentor check in
- Peer tutoring during advisory
- Tutoring could be subject specific or focused more on organizational skills depending on the needs of the student

- Assign a lunch buddy




# 5th Grade Visit
