Rancho Santa Fe Education Foundation

Founded in 2007 as a merger of the two prior organizations

- The Rancho Santa Fe Endowment Fund: Founded in 1997 by ten school families @ \$100K each for the purpose of raising funds to keep class sizes small (20<)
- The Parent Teacher Organization (PTO): Founded in 1982 to coordinate parent volunteers and raise funds for selected student & family enrichments (Halloween Carnival, SDD, Field Day Band, etc).

Why did they merge?

- Confusion & competition among parents led to the erosion of support for both
- PTO began hiring select teaching specialists (math/science)
- Double-up for the same donor base/cause

Mission of the RSFEF (Bylaws Article 2.1)

"The purpose of this Corporation is to maintain small class sizes, to enhance the educational activities and programs of the Rancho Santa Fe Elementary and Middle Schools, and to support the administration, its policies and programming."

- Business logo or name listed on the online Consumer Guide (Bronze+)


Community Partners

Update:

- Team effort: prospects came from Education Board, Foundation Board, parents and staff
- Collected \$51,760 to date exceeding this year's goal of \$35k by 48%
- We currently have 49 paying Community Partners. We also have 14 in-kind CPs (value = \$20,600)

Current Status of Endowment is \$5,964,755 (as of 12/16/20)


Endowment distributions have increased each year as the fund grows

- Distribution calculated based on a 12-quarter trailing average
- Last few years has been a 4% dispersement
- Distribution for the 2020/21 school year is \$209,311

10% of annual giving contributions go back to the Endowment

- To date, we have invested \$54,000 back into the Endowment this year

Annual Grant Update


- Raised 110% of goal YTD with 6 months remaining
- YTD Cash to District: ~\$700k
- YTD Cash to Endowment: \$54k

Scholars' Circle Members

- 12 new Scholars' Circle Families (1 Magna CL, 11 CL)
- 33 Active Scholars' Circle Families (23 SC Completed Families)
- Scholars' Circle is important as it allows the school to budget for longterm goals

Participation of Families

- Total Family Participation: 56.6%
- New Family Participation: 72.9%
- Participation is the key to forging and maintaining relationships with businesses who become our Community Partners as it shows them that our school families support the Foundation's endeavors
