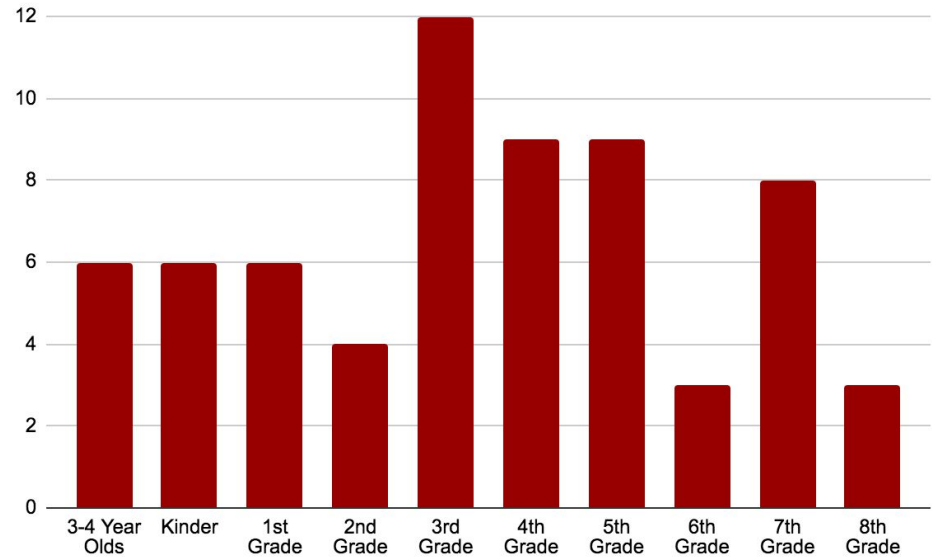
Special Education

It is the right of every handicapped individual from age 3 – 21 to receive free appropriate public educational services to meet their unique needs.

RSF Special Education

66 Students Currently Eligible

- 12% of the student population (state average is 11-13%)
- Service plan for each student varies depending on need

K-5 Learning Center

- Serves students with mild to moderate disabilities
- Typically students have goals in one or more academic areas
- Students typically receive their primary instruction from general education teachers

Services are provided as:

- Consultation
- Push-in support to the general education classroom
- Direct instruction in the learning center

6-8 Learning Center

- Serves students with mild to moderate disabilities
- Typically students have goals in one or more academic areas
- Students typically receive their primary instruction from general education teachers

Services are provided as:

- Consultation
- Directed Studies Class
- Co-Taught Classes
- Fundamentals Classes (Math and English-Language Arts)

Special Day Classroom

- Serves students with moderate to severe disabilities
- Typically students have goals in academic and adaptive skills areas
- Students typically receive their primary instruction from special education teachers

Services are provided as:

- Direct instruction in the SDC
- Push-in support to the general education classroom

Speech Services

- Serves students with mild to severe disabilities
- Students have goals in articulation, language, and/or pragmatic skills

Services are provided as:

- Consultation
- Direct instruction with speech department

2021 Department Changes

Added a Special Education Teacher position

- Providing Math and Reading Intervention in Middle School
- Added Co-Taught classes for Math, Reading, and Writing
