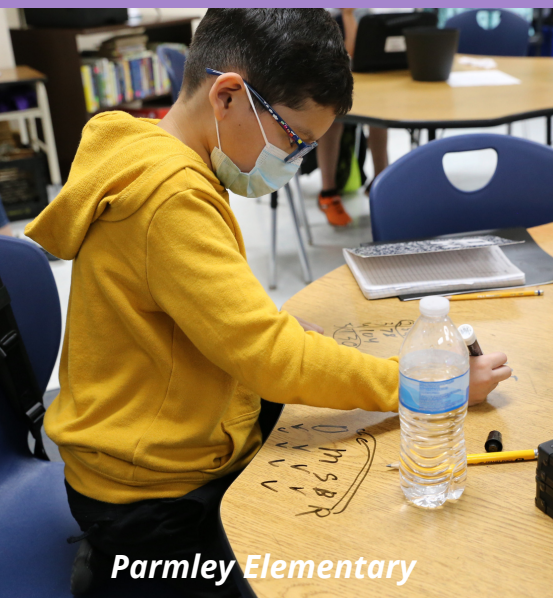

## FREE BREAKFAST FOR ALL STUDENTS

Beginning Monday, September 14



Willis ISD is excited to announce that beginning Monday, Sept. 14, all students will be eligible to receive a FREE Breakfast to start their day, thanks to an approval from the organization, "Universal Breakfast."

On average, students who eat school breakfast have been shown to score 17.5 percent higher on standardized math tests and attend 1.5 more days of school per year. Research also shows that students who attend class more regularly are 20 percent more likely to graduate high school.

# WILDKAT FOOTBALL FUNDRAISER

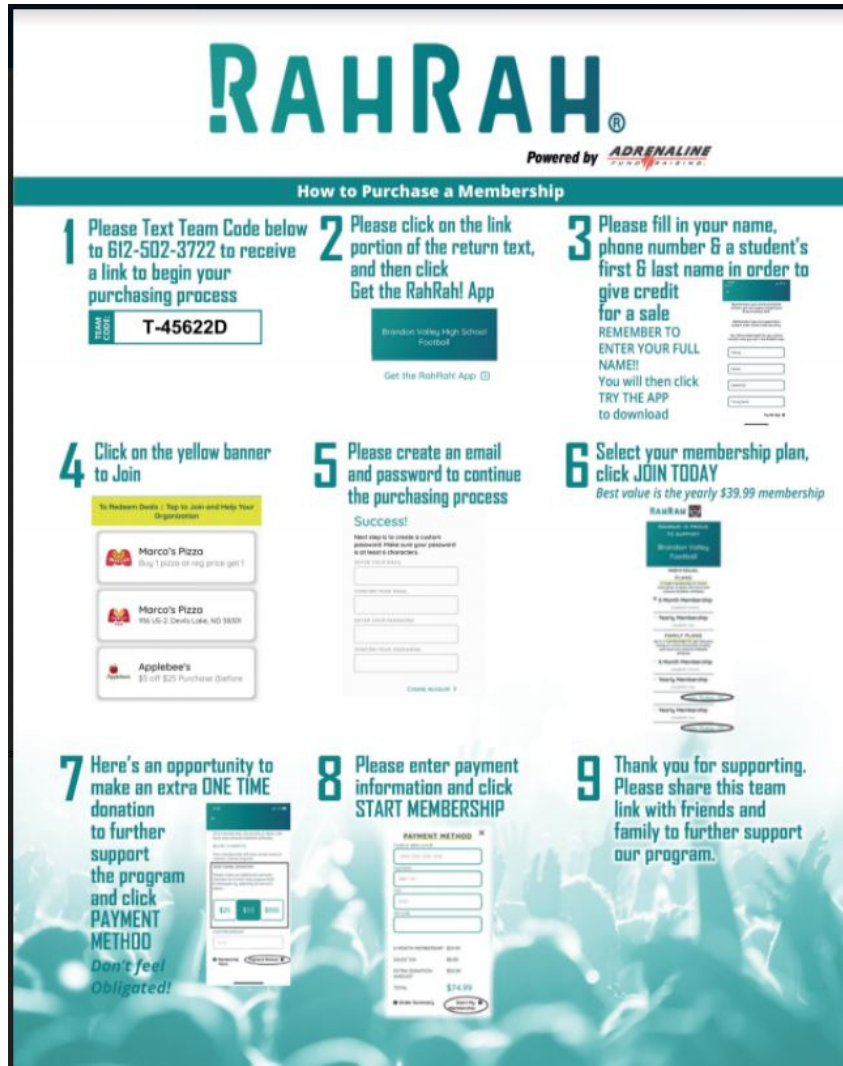

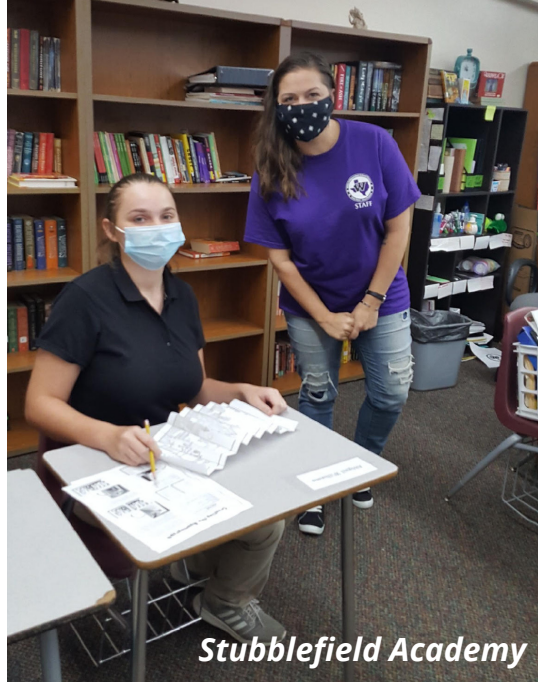
