OLENTANGY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO FILL VACANCY – APPLICATION AVAILABLE

The Olentangy Schools Board of Education is seeking a community member to fill the remaining 1.5 years of an unexpired term. Board member Mindy Patrick announced her resignation from the board on May 26 after completing 2.5 years of her second four-year term serving Olentangy Schools.

“The Olentangy Board of Education is looking for a resident who is interested in serving our community by working with district administration to achieve our mission of facilitating maximum learning for every student,” said Board of Education President Kevin G. O’Brien. “The board looks forward to reviewing applications and meeting with community members who are interested in filling this open member position.”

An application to fill the vacant seat is available on the [district’s website](#). Completed applications must be submitted to Olentangy Schools through the online application by June 7. The board welcomes, but is not requiring, further information from interested applicants in addition to the online application.

The board will meet in executive session on June 9 to review all applications. If it is determined that interviews are necessary, the board will complete them by June 19. The board will then appoint the new member at the June 23 meeting.

Under Ohio Revised Code, the remaining members of the board may fill a vacancy at their first regular or special meeting within a window period of 10 to 30 days following the date on which the vacancy occurs. The appointee shall serve the rest of Patrick’s unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2023.
