Olentangy Schools is pleased to announce that Greta Gnagy has been named principal of the district's newest elementary school, opening Fall 2021.

Gnagy brings 20 years of experience in education to the role and is currently the assistant principal at Olentangy Orange Middle School. She joined the district in 2003, and has since served students through coaching, teaching, mentoring, and in various leadership and principal capacities.

Upon acceptance of the position, Gnagy shared "I am beyond excited for this amazing opportunity. We are going to build a culture embedded with optimism, pride, and a sense of belonging for these students."

The school largely resembles the layout of Olentangy's other elementary schools, with six additional classroom spaces.
