School Volunteer Guidelines

- Volunteers must complete the volunteer application form.
- All district rules and policies must be adhered to. Please familiarize with the policies and handbooks found online at www.usd470.com.
- Volunteers must sign-in with the office staff and wear a badge when volunteering.
- Volunteers must strictly adhere to confidentiality guidelines.
- Volunteers should not discriminate or exhibit behavior that could be offensive.
- All activities between a volunteer and student(s) must take place on school property and during the regular school/extended day. Any exceptions must follow school district guidelines and have principal or administrative approval.
- Volunteers may not transport students.
- Volunteers should minimize physical contact with students. Limit physical contact to generally accepted gestures of greetings, guidance, or praise (ex: shaking hands, high fives).
- Volunteers must interact with students in 'open areas' of the school. There should be no interaction in a room with the door closed or in a remote area of the school.
- Volunteers may not use profanity or exhibit displays of violence (including threats).
- Volunteers may not engage in any illegal activities with students.
- Volunteers may not attempt to influence or persuade students on religious or political matters.
- Volunteers shall not make negative comments about or in front of students and staff.
- Volunteers should report any problems to the teacher or principal immediately.
