### THE DWIGHT SCHOOLS

The Dwight Schools, a world-renowned network of independent International Baccalaureate World Schools, was founded in New York in 1872. Dwight now has campuses in New York, London, Seoul, Shanghai, and Dubai, as well as a campus in the cloud, Dwight Global Online. Each campus is independent, yet connected to the network's central administration in New York, ensuring that all students receive an equally excellent, personalized educational experience. Students participate in a wide range of cross-campus exchanges, curricular and creative collaborations, and community service and leadership programs. The Dwight Schools network boasts an international student body representing over 50 nationalities with graduates who enroll in top colleges and universities in North America, Europe, Asia, Australia, and worldwide.

### DWIGHT GLOBAL ONLINE SCHOOL

Founded in 2014, Dwight Global is the online campus of The Dwight Schools network. A pioneer in online education, the school offers students worldwide a college-preparatory experience equivalent to that of a brick-and-mortar independent school, but with greater accessibility. Initially intended for students pursuing demanding careers in dance, music, acting, and sports, **Dwight Global now also attracts students for its rigorous academics, including extensive AP and IB offerings, synchronous classes, diverse student body, and rich extracurricular opportunities.** Dwight Global students experience a flipped-classroom model with twice-weekly college-style seminars dedicated to rich academic inquiry.

### SPECIAL PROGRAMS AND COURSES

Dwight Global encourages and provides both in-person and virtual opportunities for students to collaborate with faculty and peers.

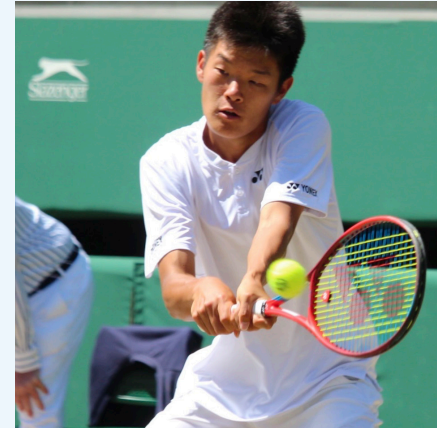
**STEAM Weekend:** In addition to our annual in-person orientation, our STEAM weekend takes place on Dwight New York's campus each spring and brings together students in grades 6-12 from all over the country and globe. The multidisciplinary STEAM program ignites academic investigation and discourse as students explore themes such as "NYC Under the Microscope" and the "Science of Food and Taste."

**IB Diploma Program:** Our pilot for the delivery of the IB DP entirely online began in 2022 with a class of nine students, and has grown to include 20 for the Class of 2024. Dwight Global received international recognition when it was selected by the International Baccalaureate as a partner for this pilot.

**Spark Projects:** From writing, producing, and directing a play to starting a non-profit organization that addresses food insecurity, students pursue their passions or "spark of genius." Each Spark Project requires months of independent inquiry and planning, and culminates in a presentation of the project to a committee of faculty and students.

**English Senior Seminar:** Designed to engage students in a college-level English course, prerequisites include completion of an AP English course or earned departmental approval. Students begin with a film study and analysis in trimester one, move into the study of nature in literature in trimester two, and end the year with an examination of graphic novels in trimester three. Weekly writing assignments focus on specific literary techniques, stylistic features and/or inferential messages. Each trimester ends with a cumulative assessment, challenging students to analyze material in a variety of forms.

**Dwight Partnerships:** Dwight Global students may cross-register at any Dwight brick-and-mortar campus; students at four of our Dwight campuses are currently enrolled in courses through Dwight Global. Dwight Global also boasts numerous faculty members from Dwight's network of schools. *Students residing in New York have the opportunity to earn a diploma from Dwight School New York upon completion of graduation requirements.*

### GPA

- Dwight Global does not add weight to any courses.
- Average unweighted cumulative average GPA is based on end-of-the-year junior grades and only includes Dwight Global courses: 90.08%
- GPA distribution: Dwight Global offers two very rigorous paths for students: our AP and IB curricula. We do not report GPA distributions given the unique nature of each curriculum. Also, students may enter Dwight Global throughout their high school journey, including senior year. Dwight Global does not include outside courses in our GPA calculations.
