

- 4 folders with pockets & brads (1-red, 1-blue, 1- yellow, 1-green) (plastic preferred)
- 3 composition notebooks
- 1 pkg notebook paper (2<sup>nd</sup> grade only)- 100 wide-ruled sheets
- 2 pkgs of pencils (12 pack #2 wooden)
- 2 box of crayons (24 count)
- 1 pkg of washable markers (8 pack, broad tip, classic colors)
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors (blunt tip, Fiskars brand recommended)
- 2 Pink Pearl Erasers
- 1 supply box (plastic preferred)
- 1 box of tissues
- Headphones
- 1 backpack (no wheels) large enough to accommodate folders
- Water bottle or thermos

Project Back to School provides free school supplies and backpacks for WFISD students who qualify for the free and reduced lunch program. \*\*Must bring proof of eligibility to Roundup to get school supplies such as school eligibility letter, Medicaid, CHIP, Lone Star card, or other proof of receiving government assistance.

## If you attend Burgess, Lamar, Scotland Park, Booker T Washington, or Zundy elementary schools, you will receive school supplies and backpacks at your school when school begins -- NOT at the Roundup.

Project Back to School Roundup is Saturday, August 6, 2022, at the Wichita Falls MPEC at 1000 5th St from 9 am to noon. Each family is limited to 2 members to pick up supplies. If you are receiving school supplies from Project Back to School, you only need to purchase the following items:

- 1 supply box
- 1 box of tissues
- Headphones

Wish List (These items are not required, but are often needed in class throughout the year.)

- Hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol-based; no methanol)
- Wet wipes (bleach free)
- Bottle of Elmer's glue
- 2 Dry Erase Markers (fine tip)
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- Additional tissues, glue sticks, crayons, composition notebooks, scissors
- Ziploc bags (quart or gallon size)
