

- 5 folders with pockets & brads (different colors, if possible)
- 4 composition notebooks
- 1 pkg of colored pencils
- Erasers (Pink pearl or pencil toppers)
- 2 pkgs of notebook paper (100 wide ruled sheets)
- 1 pkg markers (8 count, broad tip, classic, washable)
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 pkgs of pencils (12 pack, #2 wooden)
- Scissors
- 1 box of crayons (24 ct) 3<sup>rd</sup> grade only
- 1 zipper pencil bag
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Earbuds
- 1 backpack (no wheels) large enough to accommodate folders
- Water bottle or thermos

Project Back to School provides free school supplies and backpacks for WFISD students who qualify for the free and reduced lunch program. \*\*Must bring proof of eligibility to Roundup to get school supplies such as school eligibility letter, Medicaid, CHIP, Lone Star card, or other proof of receiving government assistance.

## If you attend Burgess, Lamar, Scotland Park, Booker T Washington, or Zundy elementary schools, you will receive school supplies and backpacks at your school when school begins -- NOT at the Roundup.

Project Back to School Roundup is Saturday, August 6, 2022, at the Wichita Falls MPEC at 1000 5th St from 9 am to noon. Each family is limited to 2 members to pick up supplies. If you are receiving school supplies from Project Back to School, you only need to purchase the following items:

- 1 zipper pencil bag
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Earbuds

Wish List (These items are not required, but are often needed in class throughout the year.)

## • Hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol-based; no methanol)

- Notecards (3.5 x 5)
- Wet wipes (bleach free)
- Tissues
- Glue sticks
- 2 Dry erase markers (fine tip)
- Ziploc baggies (quart size)

An additional supply list may be sent at the beginning of the second semester to replenish needed items.
