What is the Louisville Fund?

The Louisville Fund is our most important fundraising initiative. Tuition revenue covers approximately 80% of our operating budget. Our goal is to raise the other 20% through donations to the Louisville Fund. This critical campaign enables us to provide an exceptional education while minimizing tuition increases and giving families the opportunity to receive a tax deduction for a portion of the cost paid to educate their daughter(s).

What does the Fund cover?

Your unrestricted donations help us support the mission of the Sisters of St. Louis and continue to provide a stellar education for our students, which includes individualized attention, appropriate equipment, dedicated and well-trained faculty, and a robust mix of experiences.

How can my family participate?

Because the Louisville Fund is critical to the education of every student, Louisville expects every current family to make a meaningful contribution to the best of their ability. Our campaign goals include 100% parent, faculty/staff, and board of directors' participation. We also rely heavily on the generous donations of alumnae and parents of alumnae.

What is the best way to give as an alumna?

We highly encourage all alumnae to donate to Louisville because it supports current and future Royals and guarantees the strength of their educational credentials for years to come. Donating to the Louisville Fund is a way for alumnae to pay forward their student experience which was supported by the generosity of donors. Our Louisville GEMs (Give Every Month) is a recurring gift program that is a convenient way to make a lifelong impact on our young women.

Do my donations to the gala or the paddle raise count toward the Louisville Fund?

Events and specific initiatives like a paddle raise are very important to Louisville because they help us fund specific items that enhance our educational experience which are not covered in our operating budget. These are separate initiatives from the Louisville Fund. While we encourage you to donate to these areas, our highest priority is the Louisville Fund.

What is the Annual Report?

Tri-annually we publish a magazine, the *Royal View*, one of which includes our Annual Report. The Annual Report highlights areas that have been positively impacted by the generosity of our community. We list all donors who have given in any capacity to Louisville during the prior fiscal year (July 1 – June 30) as a sign of our gratitude.

How is the Fund allocated?

Our principal, president, business manager, and finance committee determine how donations to the Louisville Fund are best allocated. These funds are never directed to capital projects, such as building initiatives, but only to yearly budget items that benefit all students equally.

Can I give through my employer?

Some employers will offer a payroll contribution plan where employees can set up automatic payroll deductions. They may also offer a corporate matching program. Please contact your employer for more details.

How much should I give?

Giving is a personal decision, and we ask each family to give to the best of their ability. No gift is too small and each is valued. Contributions of all sizes add up to big differences in our vitality. All gifts are acknowledged on our Louisville Fund list which is posted and emailed periodically. Additionally, gifts of \$1,500 and higher will be recognized at our President's reception and gifts of \$2,500 and higher will receive further recognition.
