The Foundation has been incorporated and the first Board of Directors consists of Mike Bell, Dr. Edward Bowes, Nancy Campbell, Nancy Cline, Dr. Andrew Crowley, Jackie Deppe, Claire Dunbar, Thomas Featheringill, William Gossett, Kay Pruett, David Sleepy, Dennis Smith, Robert Weidenbener, and Bart York.

Elected in July to serve until the annual

meeting in October were Chairman Bart York, Vice Chairman Robert Weidenbener, and Secretary/Treasurer Claire Dunbar.

The board of education of the MSD of Wayne Township, the school board has adopted a resolution supporting both the mission and purpose of the Foundation and has appointed school board member Thomas Featheringill to serve as an ex-officio member on the foundation's board of directors.

Endowed Funds

What is an endowed fund?

- Funds that provide funding long into the future from the interest earned. Examples include scholarship and program funds.
- Typically, they are named funds in memory or tribute to an individual, opportunity, or organization.

Can I establish an endowed fund?

- Yes, through WTEF's Endowment Program, donors may designate funds with a minimum gift of \$10,000.






