



SEVERE WEATHER CLOSURES

Impact on Community Education classes, programs and Facility User groups.

There is always a potential for severe weather warranting building closings or delays during winter months. Many variables are considered in order to best ensure the safety of all community members, students, and staff. With the complexity of making weather-related decisions, even neighboring school districts may not reach the same decision.

With each situation, we will do our best to communicate early and in multiple formats if scheduled activities or facility user groups will be impacted. These announcements are not always on media outlets, as they may be a class by class decision. **Please check your email regularly when there is a threat of severe weather.**

First and foremost, safety is always the priority when making decisions that will impact students and community members.

FACILITY USER GROUP INFORMATION

If severe weather warrants a building closure, all facility user group rentals would also be cancelled. We will do our best to reach out to groups the day before if there is ample warning. We will only reach out to the contact listed on the Facility User group account. Please ensure you let your participants know, and that you check your email frequently.

ADVENTURE CENTER, ECFE & PRESCHOOL CLASS INFORMATION

In the event of school cancellation, all Adventure Center and Early Childhood classes and programs will be cancelled. In the event of delayed start, Adventure Center programs will open 2 hours late and all morning ECFE and CI Preschool classes will be cancelled. In the event of an early dismissal, afternoon Adventure Center would not be open after school. All preschoolers must be picked up at the end of the school day. Further details would be communicated by email, text and phone messages.

ABE, AQUATICS, ENRICHMENT & RECREATION PROGRAMS

All programs would be cancelled if schools were cancelled for the day. However, there are also times when we have to close down classes/programs due to impending severe weather and the schools have NOT been closed down. These decisions would be related to weather and road conditions, and would be meant to protect the safety of participants and staff. In this situation, we would communicate with participants and instructors as early and often as possible. Email and our [Facebook page](#) will be our primary form of communication for these updates.

In the event of any cancellations, we will contact participants using the email listed in our registration program, [Eleyo](#). If your cell phone number is listed in the "mobile" field in the system, you will also receive a text message. We will post updates on Facebook and our website.
