**GREETINGS** – MR. TODD SEIS

At 4:05 p.m., Mr. Seis opened the meeting and greeted everyone before introductions were made.

MINUTES FROM THE LAST MEETING - MR. TODD SEIS

Minutes were approved by the committee.

### **Motion:** Approve the minutes with changes

Presentation on Sales Tax New Construction and Renovation Projects including an overview of other non-sales tax construction projects occurring throughout the district — Mr. Ron Young

Mr. Young provided an update on the major construction projects.

### Presentation By Mr. Chris Butera, SVN Alliance - Mr. Chris Butera

Mr. Butera provided an excellent presentation on the Volusia County residential projects and answered question throughout the presentation. The following questions were asked with Mr. Butera's responses:

- Mr. Aten: What is a CDD?
  - Community Development District.
- Ms. Bishop: What is the status of Avalon Park?
  - It is going through site approvals (3,000 acres) and the site has a lot of challenges like wetlands,
     bad soils. It could also be that the builder is waiting for the market to improve.
- Ms. Bishop: Any Update on the Lennar project in South Deltona?
  - No update.
- Ms. Bishop: Are any golf courses being built in the luxury communities?
  - Yes, there is one.
- Mr. Aten: Asked about Senate Bill 102 (The Live Local Housing Bill) and the effect on the housing market?
  - The builders are looking at affordable housing options like stand-alone garages with in-laws' suites in order to create an additional rental unit on a property. If there is financing available through a bill like tax credits etc., these projects will happen.
- Mr. Aten: Shared that his understanding is that there is a provision that allows developers to purchase
  what's traditionally not a residential property for affordable housing. How will residential developers
  competing for the commercial property impact the housing market?
  - The affordable housing developments work with tax credits. It's like a lottery system. Affordable housing is a lucrative business.
- Mr. Lammers: What is the timeline for the development in Edgewater.
  - Mr. Butera shared that we might be able to see a lot of development within the next five years.
- Mr. Seis: Is there any truth to that builders are actually sitting on their lots and not building on purpose?
  - Yes, there is some truth to that. The builders were doing that when the market was red hot and getting ahead of themselves and signing contracts for houses they couldn't quite deliver yet. And then by the time the houses were delivered, they realized they could have sold it for 5-10% higher than doing a contract a number of months ago.

- The financial information broken down by referendum categories was shared.
- A consolidated statement and detail report of total expenditures from Inception through February 28, 2023, for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2023, was also shared.

- At the committee members' request, additional information regarding the revenues was added.
  - o The revenues generated through 2022: \$364,756,443
  - o Revenues to date for 2023: \$35,289,492

#### FOLLOW UP ITEMS FROM THE LAST MEETING - MR. TODD SEIS

#### a. Sunshine Law:

- Ms. Bishop: Not satisfied by the answer provided by Mr. Pendley. She stated, "He told us that our only job was to produce the report. We are of the opinion that we give our advice and recommendations to the board. That would be under Sunshine. If we only do the report, we are not obligated to be under Sunshine."
- o Mr. Aten: Agreed with Ms. Bishop and said that was his understanding as well.
- o Two Open Issues:
  - Does POC fall under the Sunshine Law?
  - What is the purpose of the group?
- b. **Research the \$1,328** under the 'Actuals' under COPs 2021A Monthly Financial Statement for Osceola Elementary:
  - o Correction will be made in the April's Financial Statement.
- c. The board voted to replace **Starke Elementary.** Are there any contracts/bids on that?
  - Mr. Young to provide an update.
- d. Project Description for Starke Elementary: Replacement Vs. Renovations and Additions
  - o Mr. Tom Brown explained the process and why it would be difficult to change the description.
  - With Department of Education's approval, the architects' agreement has been amended and a change to the scope of work within that agreement has been done to address the replacement of the schools instead of just renovating it.
  - Ms. Burke-Bishop asked if there would be any building left standing? Mr. Brown shared that there will not any buildings left.
  - o Based on the Castaldi report, there is no issue with total replacement.
  - Ms. Burke-Bishop voiced her concerns on leaving the description as a renovation project and not changing it to a replacement.
- e. Request to add "Actual Revenues" in the summary report:
  - o **Completed**. This was added to this month's summary report.

### f. HVAC/Facilities Condition Index Report (FCI)

- Facilities Condition Index (FCI) report is in progress. BRPH has been contracted to work on this
  report which is a four-week process. After the report is submitted to the district, several internal
  meetings will be held to prioritize and categorize items on the report.
- Another update has been requested from Mr. Young.

### g. Material Costs

o **Completed**. However, request was made to bring back the updated cost sheet to share with the committee on a monthly basis.

### h. Science Classroom Survey

Update will be provided in July by Dr. Johnson.

### ERP Software Funding Source

- Sales tax fund will be used for the implementation of the ERP software. LCIF would cover the recurring licenses for the student software.
- o Right now, no budget has been set aside for the new ERP in the five-year work plan.
- Ms. Burke-Bishop raised concerns about a potential whistleblower situation arising again and suggested being prepared to address it, as a significant amount of money was spent on fixing the previous issue with Cherry Road contractor for the Oracle ERP, which was unsuccessful.
