ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION – COMMUNICATION WITH THE PUBLIC

AR 1100

The Communications Office will:

1. Disseminate information to the public through periodic release of activities, goals and accomplishments of the County Board of Education, administration, staff, and programs.
2. Inform the public, staff, and districts of policies, planning, and programs through a variety of media.
3. Maintain a continuing program of internal and external information.
4. Assign staff for this program and provide adequate resources for implementation and operation.
5. Remain accessible to the public and representatives of news media.
6. Provide opportunities for the involvement of the public, teachers, and students for input into the process of schooling.
7. Use available means of communication to stimulate public understanding of critical issues in public education to help create an informed electorate.
