The Santa Barbara County Superintendent of Schools is an elected official, with rights, duties, and responsibilities to administer the staff and programs of the County Education Office.

The County Superintendent of Schools is the employer of staff of the County Education Office and of the programs operated by the County Education Office.

The administration of the County Education Office as it relates to the County Superintendent and the County Board of Education is covered in Education Code Sections 1040-1042 and 1240-1293.
