


ASH AT A GLANCE





2022 examples: Positivity Playground, a place for educators who want to learn more about building staff wellbeing, energy, engagement, and teamwork through Positive Peer Coaching.

Global Online Academy (GOA) and their center for professional learning, NEASC professional learning events, ECIS as our regional and global network of international educators.

INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT

In addition to bringing staff development to the school, we also support individuals and teams with wide-ranging professional learning opportunities. For the school year 2021-2022, we supported over 150 event registrations, school wide, reaching about 100 individuals or 40% of the staff. Some of the professional learning themes include: Sustainability, DEIJ, AP/IB, Inquiry, Visible Wellbeing, Leadership, Literacy, Languages, Math, Science, Music, Art, PE, Counseling, Social Studies, Design Thinking.

EMBEDDED PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

Embedded professional learning in order to provide even greater access to learning opportunities in order to develop higher levels of self-efficacy and positively impact student learning.

2022 examples: middle level leadership capacity development workshop series, "Instant Tech," asynchronous, bite-sized tech lessons, workshops for all ability levels to create online units and lessons in our virtual learning environment.



A FEW EXAMPLES OF LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL OPPORTUNITIES



Service learning trips are part of ASH SDG Academy, year-long extracurricular programs that allow ASH students in grades 9 to 12 to partner directly with communities around the world, and take collective action on one of the UN Sustainable Development Goals. In 2022-2023 students traveled to Nepal, Thailand, and Belgium.
