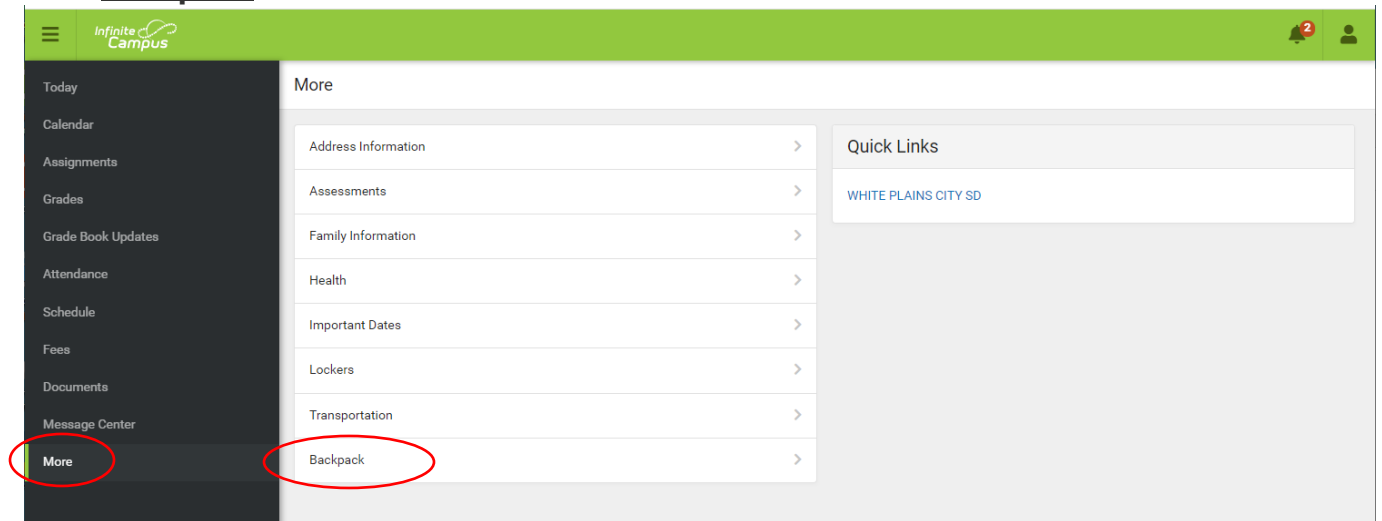
Infinite Campus Portal App for Apple iOS or Droid

Click **More** from the bottom left menu

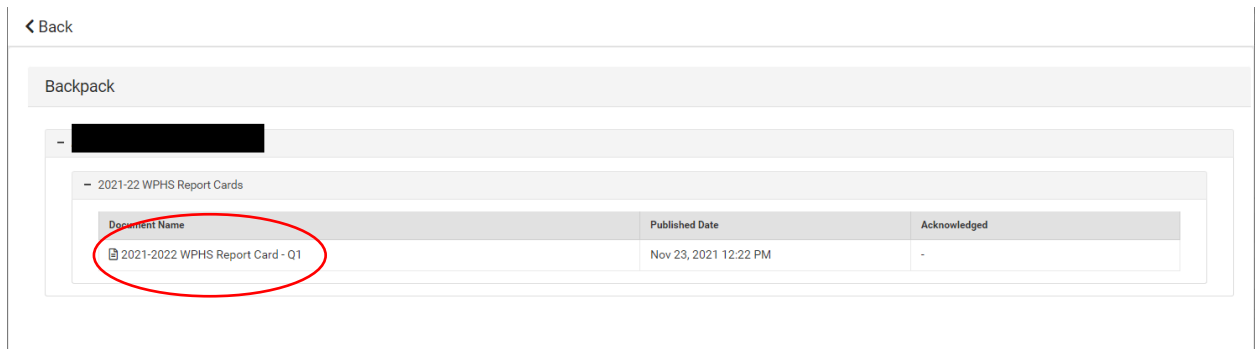
Click **Backpack**
