

## INSTRUCTIONS

### **BOARD POLICY - COMMUNITY DAY SCHOOL**

BP 6185

The County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools, pursuant to provisions of law, will ensure that an alternative educational placement is provided for expelled students, certain probation referred students and students referred through a formal district process.

A student may be assigned to community day school only upon meeting one or more of the following conditions:

1. The student has been expelled from his/her home school district for any reason.
2. The student is probation referred.
3. The student has been referred by a school attendance review board (SARB) or other district level referral process.

### **Referral/Assignment Procedures**

A school district expelling or involuntarily transferring a student to the Community Day School shall be advised of the requirements of Administrative Regulation 6014 of the Santa Barbara County Education Office and shall be expected to comply with the stated requirements.

### **Student Due Process**

The County Superintendent will provide for fair treatment of students by affording them their due process right under the law. Procedures governing student due process shall conform in all aspects to provisions in law.
