Silsbee High School & SISD require summer reading if a student selects to take an English Pre-AP or AP course. This allows the class to begin with common discourse, exposing students to rich texts while maintaining a high standard in our advanced coursework. Your student is required to choose and read ONE of the following texts by the end of the second week of school.* The text can be checked out through the public library, or it can be purchased independently. If a copy cannot be attained either of these ways, parents can check out a text through the front office at SHS during summer hours. Parents, please assist your child in selecting the text that you find most appropriate. As students read, they should use the accompanying journal to capture significant ideas. Students will submit the journal at the end of the second week of school and use it to assist them with a writing assignment.

*Students entering a Pre-Ap or AP English course after the first week (but within the first two progress reporting periods) will be provided 2 weeks to read the selected text and complete the journal.
