### LIT Partnership Meeting October 6, 2022

### Items of Discussion:

*New Business:* Math College Prep class is ready to go. FERPA rules apply to minor college students. We can only restate information and refer them to LIT.

*Starfish access:* K. Barron needs to contact IT and request 3rd party access.

*College Prep Hist 1301 Sophomores:* What is their TSIA2 status if they fail the fall semester since that is the only course they are taking that requires the TSIA2? They can still take courses at LIT and LIT only but they are not considered TSI complete until they pass a class.

*October 11 Staff Development Day:* Ms. Swope will be coming to visit with our adjunct faculty sometime after 9:30 am.

*Degree audit for Juniors and Seniors:* We received a jump drive with this information.

*Criminal Justice Spring Semester:* CRIJ 1310 is the next class on the pathway. Ms. Mitchell built it already. We will officially begin this pathway in the spring semester. Abby Durr will come again in the spring to help get our kids signed up with GoApplyTexas at a later date.

*Silsbee Showcase:* This is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, January 26, 2023 at 5:30pm.

*College Prep English Spring 2023:* There are no changes in the syllabus. Check with Ms. Marshall for the codes.

*Spring 2023 Courses:* We already know approximately how many sections of each course we will need for the spring semester. We would like real person "wellness check" for Biology. Ms. Celeste is pregnant and will be on maternity leave. It is possible that History 1302 will be hybrid or entirely online next semester. LIT may make 3 online sections but that will not affect our classes here. Mr. Rawls will continue to come in that afternoons for Arts 1301 just as he is this semester. We will also need to have 2 online sections of Econ 2301 for the spring semester with the same professor for both sections if possible.

*Certificate Pathway for Non-Core or AA students:* We are going to collaborate with LIT to create and offer this option to our kids that will not complete the AA or Core 42. The course work does not depend on the TSI. We will have to have conversations with parents of struggling students in May, advising them that this may be a better option. They will earn a management and entrepreneurship certificate with a business or office management focus.

*Welding Update:* Silsbee has 117 students co-enrolled in Welding.
