## Required Materials

#### ALL:

- Quality instrument/equipment from a recommended source (NO COLORED INSTRUMENTS!) Please visit <u>CoppinvilleBand.com</u> for a purchasing guide or request a physical guide from Mrs. Compton
- Metronome/Tuner
  - Recommended Apps: Soundcorset (tuner/metronome, free); Bandmate Chromatic Tuner (free); TonalEnergy (tuner/metronome, \$3.99)
- Portable Music Stand for at home practice

#### Woodwind Classes:

- Cork Grease for Clarinet and Saxophones
- Swab specific for instrument
- Flute Rod (Flutes only)
- Reeds for Clarinet and Saxophones (Students should have 3 working reeds at ALL times)
  - Recommended: Join the Playground Music Reed Club to have reeds delivered to OUR bandroom each month. Please contact Playground Music at (850) 243-2514 for more information and pricing
  - o Acceptable Brands: Vandoren, Royal by D'Addario, or Juno
  - o Strength 2.5 **unless** Mrs. Compton has recommended moving to a Strength 3

#### Brass Classes:

- Valve oil for Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone and Tuba
- Slide Grease for all
- Slide cream + spray bottle, such as Slide-O-Mix or Trombotine, for Trombones
- Cleaning Snake
- Polishing Cloth (Please do not use towels or washcloths! They will scratch the finish)

#### Percussion Classes:

- \$175 Class fee covers all needed materials.
- Broken or damaged mallets/sticks, will be replaced by the student at an additional cost. Required equipment make and model information will be provided by request.

#### **Expectations for Members in Good Standing**

As members of the Coppinville Junior High School Bands, you are expected to:

- 1. Be on time.
- 2. Be where you are supposed to be. Be doing what you are supposed to be doing.
- 3. Follow the classroom rules and procedures.
- 4. Be prepared for all classes, rehearsals, and performances.
- 5. Make a positive contribution to the band program.
- 6. Display exemplary conduct at all times.
- 7. Meet eligibility requirements as defined by school policy.
- 8. Attend all rehearsals.
- 9. Attend all concerts.
- 10. Follow all policies of the Enterprise City Schools Board of Education and Coppinville Jr. High School as set forth in the student handbook.

Please note that in addition to these expectations, all of the Coppinville Junior High School and Enterprise City Schools Board of Education rules and expectations as set forth in the Student Handbook will also apply! Any student who does not meet the high standards of the Coppinville Junior High School Bands is subject to review, disciplinary action, and/or dismissal at the discretion of the band director.

## **Grading Policy**

Your student will be graded on the following:

- Participation 60%
  - Student is awarded 100 points at the beginning of each week.
  - o Any time the student is off task, 10 points will be deducted.
  - If a student does not have any of the required materials for class (instrument, music, etc.),
     20 points will be deducted.
  - Students are encouraged to take their instrument and music home each day, but are required to do so the last school day of each week. Failure to do so will result in a 20 point deduction.
- Assessments 40%
  - o NinGenius Assignments
  - Playing Assessments (Including Midterm and Final)
  - After school rehearsals any student who does not attend for ANY reason, must complete a make up assignment
  - Concerts any student who does not attend for ANY reason, must complete a make up assignment

#### **Concert Information**

Concerts are an essential part of music education, and as such, performances are mandatory for all students. An absence from a performance will require a rigorous make-up assignment because there is no other way to replicate the experience of a live performance. These events are a showcase of their hard work! Therefore, each student should represent themselves, the organization, and the school with respect, pride, and dignity. They should be dressed appropriately for the occasion. All students are required to wear the following items:

#### Concert Black as defined:

- Solid black collared shirt, black dress pants (no jean material) or solid black skirt/dress that meets school dress code requirements with black tights/hose, long black socks (ankles should not show when seated), and black dress shoes (heels are not recommended)
- NO jewelry other than stud earrings; jewelry should not draw attention away from the group
