

New Student Registration:

Parents must accompany students to enroll and provide the following items at the time of registration:

- * Parental identification
- * Alabama blue immunization form
- * 2 Proofs of residency (utility bill, lease agreement, etc.)
- * Copy of birth certificate
- * Withdrawal form from former school
- * Transcript from former school

(We encourage parents to review transcripts from the previous school for accuracy.)

- * Copy of IEP or 504 plan, if applicable
- * Custody documentation, if applicable

Residency:

If you live inside the Enterprise city limits or on Fort Rucker:

You can enroll at Enterprise High School. You can determine this by the use of a local map or the zoning map (found on the Enterprise City Schools website).

Residency is NOT determined by bus routes. An ECS bus may service your street, but this does not necessarily mean you are in the city limits. Generally, one easy way to determine your zoning is by the color of your garbage can. Residents inside the city limits have a green garbage can. Addresses will be verified upon registration. The two proofs of residency provided at registration must be in the name of the parent or legal guardian with which the student resides. If you live inside the city limits or on Fort Rucker, call the EHS Guidance office at 475-4970 to schedule a registration appointment.

If you live outside the Enterprise city limits:

You must complete the following steps:

*Complete the NON RESIDENT ENROLLMENT REQUEST form found on the Enterprise City Schools website under the PARENT link. Return the completed request form, as well as the documentation listed on the form to the Superintendent's office at 220 Hutchinson Street where your request will be reviewed.

*Once your request is approved, you will be contacted to pay the appropriate tuition based on the tuition schedule available on the Enterprise City Schools website. You will pay your tuition at EHS. If your request is denied, you will be notified by the principal or his designee.

Once tuition has been paid, you can schedule an appointment for registration in the EHS Guidance office. Don't forget to bring the above listed documents to your registration appointment.

Athletic Eligibility (How the new Board policy regarding zoning and tuition affects athletic eligibility):

1. If you live within the city limits, Fort Rucker, or make a bona fide move into the city limits, as well as meet all the other AHSAA requirements, you should be eligible for athletics.
2. If you currently attend EHS and choose to remain a student at EHS, your eligibility will continue as long as all other AHSAA requirements are met.
3. If you currently attend EHS and live outside the city limits and choose to attend the school for which you are zoned, you may transfer your eligibility at the beginning of a school year.
4. If you live outside the city limits and are wishing to enroll at EHS, students should be eligible after one year from the date of enrollment, if all other AHSAA requirements are met.

Special note: if a current EHS student who lives outside the city limits chooses to leave EHS and enroll in the school for which they are zoned and then decides at a later date to return to EHS, the student would not be eligible for one year from the date of enrollment, if all other AHSAA requirements are met.
