# 12th grade British Literature Syllabus

Focused on the refinement of literacy skills necessary for success beyond high school, English 12 students will experience a survey of British Literature from a variety of perspectives and historical contexts. Students of this course will be challenged to conduct research using multiple sources, apply processes critical for the analysis, evaluation, and synthesis of literary and nonfiction texts, present findings in a scholarly fashion, and demonstrate fluency in writing as well as the use of digital tools through multimedia products. English 12 content standards are the culmination of curricula designed to prepare students with the skills necessary to function as literate and responsive citizens.

Selected content will be covered but is not limited to the following:
