It's summer time! Here are some ideas/additional academic resources to do with your child during the summer, if you are interested:

- 1. Go on <u>abcya.com</u> to play educational games. Look under "Pre-K" and choose games from "Letters" and "Numbers" categories.
- 2. Go on **starfall.com**, which has pattern games, number songs, calendar practice, and phonics practice. (Make sure flash is up to date for this website)
- 3. <u>Totschooling.net</u> has great instructional materials. Here, the website has themed units (Valentine's Day, Winter, etc.) to help practice Pre-K leveled skills and concepts. The website is free, and you can print/laminate the materials so they can easily be reused.
- 4. **Reading is great!** A simple bedtime story can help with comprehension and understanding concepts of print. You can ask your children questions about the pictures or text. **The Carlstadt Public Library** has a Pre-K summer reading list and is also a great place to meet new peers!
- 5. Coloring pages are great for reviewing colors and fine motor skills.
- 6. **Do some fun art projects!** Pinterest is a great tool to use when creating themed art projects for the summer. You can use dot paints or play doh to create fun art projects.
- 7. **Play outside at a park or at a community pool!** This is a great way to expose your child to other peers.
