### Grades K/1

#### **Individual Materials (please label)**

- Backpack (Regular sized, no wheels so it fits in a locker)
- 1 heavy duty plastic 2 pocket take-home folder, BLUE

#### **Shared materials (DO NOT label)**

- 4 glue sticks
- 1 box of healthy storable individually wrapped snacks
- 1 box of **Crayola** crayons (box of 24)
- 8 thin black **Expo** brand dry erase markers
- 24 **Ticonderoga** pencils, sharpened, if possible.

#### **KIndergarteners**

- 1 box **Wide Crayola** markers

- 1 box **Thin Crayola** markers

**Art/Technology**

- #2 **Ticonderoga** pencils, sharpened, if possible
- Glue Sticks ( **NOT** 'purple dries clear' )

**Nurse's Station**

- Jeans, sweatpants, stretch pants, socks, slippers, period pads
- Snacks: crunchy rollers, granola bars, Welch's gummy snacks, beef sticks, juice boxes

**Office**

**Journey (Grades 6/7/8)**

*Instead of using shared materials, our Journey students will be building the life skill of responsibility by bringing and managing their own supplies. Please label appropriately.*

*Our experience is that some shared supplies are still needed so students are successful in the classroom, those are listed as well.*

**Individual Materials (please label)**

- Grades 7/8 – **Students need a calculator.** We suggest a Scientific calculator that will be usable through grade 12. (TI-30XA or similar preferred. Contact teacher if this is a hardship.)
- All students need ONE of these systems for organizational purposes. *Let your student offer input on how they plan to organize themselves.*
  - 1 accordion file with at least 6 sections **OR**
  - A set of 6, two-pockets folders. Plastic holds up better if students are using these daily.
- Writing and Art supplies (pen, pencil, glue stick, colored pencils, ruler, markers. etc.)
- 2 erasers
- 1 manual pencil eraser
- Backpack or book bag

**Shared in the classroom**

- 1 full-size boxes of facial tissues
- 48 count, **Ticonderoga** pencils, sharpened, if possible.
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 spiral notebooks
- Gridded (graph) composition books - 2, labeled w/student name
- College ruled composition books - 2, labeled w/student name

**Later in the year...**

- Walking/hiking shoes for overnight camps / field trips

**STEAM class (optional, always needed):**

- Straws (full-size & skinny)
- Hot Glue sticks
- Masking tape
- 'Painters' Blue Tape
- Duct tape
