GROUNDBREAKING SCHEDULED FOR NORTHRIDGE VIKING STADIUM

What started out as a dream four years ago will become a reality on August 15th at 5 pm when ground is officially broken for Viking Stadium on the campus of the Northridge School District. The project launched in 2019 when the Athletic Boosters started a capital fundraising campaign with no idea a global pandemic was on the horizon. Despite unforeseen obstacles and new challenges in the field of construction related to the business growth in central Ohio, work on Viking Stadium will begin in August 2023 with a summer 2024 anticipated completion date.

"It has been a long road to get here but we never doubted that the efforts of so many people and the generosity of this community would result in a new stadium facility for our students," commented Brian Elder, Athletic Booster campaign chair. "It won't only change the landscape of the campus but will elevate the level of pride for every Viking who plays and practices in it as well as all the alumni we hope will return to see it. We are extremely grateful for the generous donations helping make this dream come true."

The project is currently in the final phase of design/development for a new 8-lane all-weather track, artificial turf, lighting, bleachers, press box, paved walkways, concession stand and restrooms. At a recent special meeting of the Northridge School Board, attended also by the Boosters and representatives from Legat Architects, Robertson Construction and Mendenhall and Associates, Northridge Treasurer/CFO Brit Lewis commented, "The amount of money raised to-date by the Boosters is absolutely amazing for a school this size. And the great news is that the Stadium Project is happening."

Superintendent Scott Schmidt commented, "I have been impressed with the incredible work that has gone on between all parties to move this project forward and to reach the point of establishing a groundbreaking date. It is a great example of the partnership between the Board and the Boosters that will ultimately have profound impact on the students at Northridge today and for years to come."
