

Community Relations

Interviews and Appearances of Students and Student Groups

The Board of Education recognizes the educational value from student participation in civic and community affairs. Teachers are encouraged to prepare students for public performances which contribute to student education to the extent that they do not interfere with other educational activities or programs.

Individual students may appear on radio or television shows at their own discretion or the discretion of their parents/guardians, provided that such appearances do not conflict with their attendance at school. Any such performance during school hours must be approved in advance by the school Principal with notification to the Superintendent.

Student groups (dramatic, musical, etc.) shall be encouraged to appear on radio and television programs provided that such appearances will reflect credit on the school and are approved in advance by the administration.
