

Business and Non-Instructional Operations

Gifts, Grants and Bequests

The Board of Education may accept any bequest or gift of money or property on behalf of, and for the schools, for a purpose deemed by the Board of Education to be suitable, and to utilize such money or property so designated.

The Superintendent shall set up criteria to be met in the acceptance of gifts, and the procedure for examining and evaluating offers of gifts to the district.
