

# What do we want teaching and learning to look like? In 3-5 years?

- Chromebooks for 2 classrooms in 3 & 4, 2 teams for 5-8

# Implementation Model

## Year 1: 2014-2015

- Ipads: Poletti, Newton, Borek, Hackbarth, Nigro, Reynolds
- Chromebooks: Bjork, Coit, Christopher, Roberts
- Chromebooks: 6th and 7th teams

## Year 2: 2015-2016

- Ipads in remaining 1st and 2nd grade classrooms
- Chromebooks in remaining 3rd and 4th grade classrooms
- Chromebooks: 5th and 8th grade teams added

# Successes and learnings from last year

## Successes:

- Increased collaboration
- Increased engagement
- Anywhere, anytime learning
- Equal access
- Students as communicators and creators


## Learning:

- Bandwidth and Access Points increased
- Damage to Chromebooks--Samsung addressed this in newer model

# Implementation Details for 2015-2016



- District owned devices
- Device, protective cover, charger provided
- Devices issued the first couple weeks of school--teachers will email parents the day the devices are issued
- No additional fee unless device is damaged/lost/stolen
- Devices go home if Parent Agreements are signed
- An additional protective sleeve is available for purchase tonight (optional)---\$10
