

Courses Existing in One School Only

Section A

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education of District #225 to authorize the superintendent to make available courses to students from both schools when a lack of facilities or student enrollment prohibit duplication.

Section B

Students from both schools shall be given equal enrollment access to such programs and facilities. If registration demands exceed available class openings, the following criteria shall be used by the superintendent in determining preference for student placement:

1. The course's importance in the continuity and sequence of the applicant's program,
2. The age and seniority of the applicant,
3. The previous academic record of the applicant.

Section C

The superintendent is authorized to provide bus shuttle service between the two schools for students in such programs.

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
