BOARD POLICY: COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

Section A

District #225 is committed to a broad experience in career education for all students. One important element of this experience is the opportunity provided students to enroll incooperative education programs. These cooperative work-study programs supplement in-school learning activities with on-the-job training.

Section B

District #225 shall provide cooperative education experiences for every qualified student in the Glenbrook schools who desires such experience. Qualifications for entry into the cooperative education programs shall be prepared by the cooperative education coordinator and approved by the superintendent.

Section C

An Advisory Committee on cooperative education shall consist of members drawn from disciplines and vocations both within and without the school.

Section D

All sites, work stations, and programs will be approved by the school and will meet criteria designed to protect the health, well-being and safety of the students and to provide for the interests and abilities of the students. (See policy on Student Trips.)
