
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Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

- 5. Input from LESD families



Dual Immersion Expansion

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- 2019-20 37% Acceptance Rate
- 2020-21 48% Acceptance Rate
- 2020-21 38 LESD families and 19 out-of-district families in Waitlisted
- First Expansion at Twain
 - Added: K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4/5 Combo teacher in order to have two teachers per grade level
- Second Expansion at Mitchell
 - Added two Kinder teachers
 - 70% of new Kinder classes are low socioeconomic status
 - 48% of new Kinder classes are EL students
 - Next year, add two First grade teachers

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


