## New Law Updates

### ***Pupil Safety: Parental Notification - Firearm safety laws (Gun Safety Notification)***

The law is a new public school requirement to inform parents and caregivers that firearms are to be safely stored away from children and teens. A “threat or perceived threat” is defined by the law as: **“any writing or action of a pupil that creates a reasonable suspicion that the pupil is preparing to commit a homicidal act related to school or a school activity.”** If local law enforcement is notified of any threat or perceived threat, the law enforcement agency or school site police must immediately conduct an investigation and assessment of the reported threat with the cooperation of the LEA. (Effective January 1, 2023). CDE will develop model content for the required notice by July 1, 2023 – in the meantime see our recommendation. **[EC 49390, 48391, and 49392]**
