

**REGULAR MEETING
BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES
BROWNSBURG COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION**

The Board of School Trustees of the Brownsburg Community School Corporation met in a regular meeting on Monday, July 11, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. in the F.L. O’Neal Administration Building, 310 Stadium Drive; Brownsburg, Indiana.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Matt Freije, Vice President of the Board, called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. Other Board members in attendance were Ms. Jessica Heffernan, Mrs. Tiffany Dearman, and Mr. Mike Wells. Mr. Eric Hylton did not attend. Administrators present were Dr. Jim Snapp, Dr. Kat Jessup, Mr. John Voigt and Mr. Shane Hacker. III. MOMENT OF REFLECTION

Dr. Freije asked for a moment of silence for reflection.

IV. COMMUNICATIONS

A. Commendation – Track Team Members

Dr. Snapp invited members of the State Runner-Up Boys Track Team forward. Senior John Colquitt won State Championships in the 110m and 300m hurdles and was undefeated in two seasons in those events. He was also member of the 4x100 Relay team that also won the State Championship. Other members of the 4x100 Real team also in attendance were Sophomore, Dominic Calhoun; Freshman, DeAndre Cooper; and Junior, Zemonda Wilson. Coach Casey Popenfoose spoke on behalf of the boys track team that took second place overall at the State Track meet. Each student received a commendation from the Board for their accomplishments.

There is a delay at the central office paving project because of unforeseen issues with the subsurface. The roofing project at Reagan is on track to be completed next week. Eagle reroofing has been delayed until fall break.

Mr. Voigt also shared an update on the round-about project at Airport Road and Green Street. The Town provides weekly updates and indicates that the intersection is scheduled to reopen to traffic the Wednesday prior to school opening.

The Administration has approved the following Special Use Agreements:

Glasshouse Bible Fellowship Church: A Special Use Agreement dated May 11, 2022 and fully executed June 30, 2022, for the period July 17, 2022 through July 9, 2023, for the use of the Reagan Elementary School Gym, to be billed \$16,900.00 paid in advance in monthly increments; this is Glasshouse's first year.

Good Samaritan Episcopal Church: A Special Use Agreement dated June 27, 2022 and fully executed July 1, 2022, for the period June 19, 2022 through June 11, 2023, for the use of the gymnasium and one classroom at Harris Academy, to be billed monthly at a rate of \$465.00 per week (subject to the actual use of the spaces); this will be Good Samaritan's second year.

Hendricks County 4-H Agricultural Fair Association: An agreement fully executed July 1, 2022, for the lease of up to four mobile bleacher units from BCSC for the county fair each July beginning with July 13-25, 2022 and ending with the 2026 county fair on July 16-28, 2026. This agreement is an extension of a similar arrangement BCSC and the County Fair have undertaken for several years, and puts in place a five-year agreement. BCSC does not charge the fair board for the use, and the fair board is responsible for the movement of the bleachers to and from the fair.

Dr. Snapp recommended the Board approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Ms. Heffernan moved to approve the recommendation; Mr. Wells seconded the motion. The Board approved the recommendation by a vote of four (4) ayes; zero (0) nays.

Dr. Snapp introduced Mrs. Kara Michael as the new assistant principal at East Middle School.

VII. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS**A. Recommendation to Approve Neighborhood Placement – Parkside at Greystone Section 2**

Dr. Jessup recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the school assignment of Parkside at Greystone, Section 2 to Cardinal Elementary/West Middle School/Brownsburg High School. She explained that Parkside at Greystone is located at CR 625 East and Northfield Drive and the neighborhood will consist of 93 homes. Section 1 of this development was also placed at

Cardinal/West. Section 2 consists of lots 26-52, 54-57 and 81-93. Dr. Jessup noted that this neighborhood placement could be subject to redistricting.

Mrs. Dearman moved to approve the recommendation; Ms. Heffernan seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of four (4) ayes; zero (0) nays.

B. Budget Presentation

Mr. Hacker provided an update to the Board regarding the budget process for the 2023 budget cycle beginning with School Finance 101. He explained the budget process and the comprehensive nature of planning and developing the budget. A copy of the budget presentation is available for review on the Corporation website.

Mr. Hacker answered several clarifying questions from Board members. There was no action required of the Board at this time.

IX. SUPERINTENDENT COMMENTS

Dr. Snapp thanked Mr. Hacker for the budget presentation. He stated it was important to note that this will be the 11th straight year for a property tax decrease.

Dr. Snapp noted that in August and September, there will be joint presentations with the Brownsburg Town Council which will include a school safety report.

Dr. Snapp shared that while the 2022 ILEARN results are embargoed, since 2016, Brownsburg has been the highest achieving school corporation in the state and that trend may continue.

IX. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mrs. Dearman thanked Mr. Davies for speaking and for all who attended the meeting. She thanked Mr. Hacker for his presentation.

Ms. Heffernan thanked Mr. Hacker for all of his hard work on the budget process.

Dr. Freije encouraged everyone to attend and support all of the BEF events. He wished everyone a successful start to the new school year.

XV. ADJOURNMENT

Dr. Freije called for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Wells moved for adjournment; Ms. Heffernan seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of four (4) ayes; zero (0) nays. The meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
