

**REGULAR MEETING
BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES
BROWNSBURG COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION**

The Board of School Trustees of the Brownsburg Community School Corporation met in a regular meeting on Monday, September 12, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. in the F.L. O’Neal Administration Building, 310 Stadium Drive; Brownsburg, Indiana.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Eric Hylton, President of the Board, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Other Board members in attendance were Ms. Jessica Heffernan, Dr. Matt Freije, Mrs. Tiffany Dearman, and Mr. Mike Wells. Administrators present were Dr. Jim Snapp, Dr. Kat Jessup, and Mr. Shane Hacker. Mrs. Jodi Gordon, Ms. Vicki Murphy, Mr. Marc Gianfagna and Dr. Bret Daghe also attended.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. MOMENT OF REFLECTION

Mr. Hylton asked for a moment of silence for reflection.

IV. COMMUNICATIONS

A. Commendation

Dr. Snapp invited Lincoln Klepper, Cardinal Elementary 3rd grade student forward. Lincoln designed a “You’re Cool” t-shirt which he has turned into a small business. He sells the t-shirts and donates a portion of the proceeds. He received a commendation from the Board for his entrepreneurial and philanthropic efforts.

B. Brownsburg Education Foundation Report

Mrs. Dearman shared the following from the Brownsburg Education Foundation:

- Designer Purse Bingo presented by Adlesperger Orthodontics took place August 16. The event sold out and raised over \$22,000.
- Annual Surplus Sale will be held Saturday, September 17 from 8:00-10:00 a.m. at the 310 Stadium Drive warehouse. Several upright pianos will be available this year. Check the BEF website for a complete list of inventory.

BCSC families and community members are invited to visit the Log Cabin Homestead and see what all BCSC third graders experience during the month of September. Enjoy pioneer games, toy making, live music and activities.

C. Operations Update

Dr. Snapp shared student immunization information. He explained there are statutory requirements for student immunizations. Our school nurses track student immunization records and those who are missing or non-compliant with immunizations are contacted. On August 5 there were 746 non-compliant students and as of September 6, there were only 53 students. Students without proper documentation as of September 6 are excluded from school until proper documentation is received.

Dr. Snapp thanked the school nurses for their work in tracking and bringing students into compliance. Mrs. Dearman asked what it looks like for students who are excluded from school. Dr. Snapp stated it is generally not for a very long period of time. Mrs. Dearman asked if this was for standard, typical vaccinations. Dr. Snapp confirmed that is the case.

D. School Safety Presentation

BCSCPD Chief Ginnie Wing and Brownsburg Police Department Chief Joe Grimes shared information about the partnership between the BCSCPD and the BPD. Chief Wing noted the longevity of her staff and the importance of building relationships in the community. She noted recent collaborations with the town in training crossing guards and joint training at the range as well as ongoing active shooter training. Chief Grimes commended the school corporation for its forward thinking in the community and for student safety by being the first in the state to institute a school police force in 2008. The foundation that was laid created a framework for the partnership shared today. BCSCPD and BPD are in regular communication, offering training and resources to provide the safest environment for our community and students. Chief Grimes notes we as a community all have a stake in this. As parents, family members, grandparents and friends. We all have to identify the red flags that might lead to a crisis. We all interact together to provide resources to those in need.

2022 BCSC Membrane and Asphalt Shingle Roofing Replacement, B&L Sheet Metal & Roofing, Inc.: On August 11, 2022 Change Order No. 001 was approved in the amount of \$252,799.21, adjusting the prior contract amount of \$2,628,250.00 to a new contract amount of \$2,881,049.21. The change order adjusts the contract for unforeseen costs associated with replacing damaged roof sheathing over the entirety of the Reagan Elementary School shingle roof system.

2022 BCSC Summer Window Replacements, Terstep Company, Inc.: On August 15, 2022 Change Order No. 001 was approved in the amount of \$465,320.00, adjusting the prior contract amount of \$1,763,000.00 to a new contract amount of \$2,228,320.00. The change order adjusts the contract for unforeseen costs associated with installing additional structural supports at most window openings at Cardinal and Delaware Trail Elementary Schools.

2022 BCSC Multi-Site Temperature Control System Replacement, ERMCO, Inc.: On September 1, 2022 Change Order No. 001 was approved. The change order authorizes the charging of \$9,199.06 to

the allowance fund within the contract amount, and therefore does not alter the current contract amount. The change order adjusts the contract to include motor fan status switched to Variable Air Volume boxes throughout Cardinal and Delaware Trail Elementary Schools.

16. Approval of a Mutual Assistance Agreement:

The Administration has entered into an agreement with St. Malachy Parish Church for the provision of emergency transportation services in the event St. Malachy school needs to be evacuated due to a human or natural disaster. This agreement formalizes an understanding that has existed between BCSC and SMPS for several years. The agreement expires on June 30, 2027. In the agreement BCSC commits to providing five school buses to shuttle approximately 575 individuals from SMPS to their primary evacuation site, which is expected to be Connection Pointe Christian Church.

17. Approval of Mutual Assistance Agreement:

The Administration has entered into an agreement with Brownsburg Meadows/American Senior Communities for the provision of emergency sheltering in the event Brownsburg Meadows needs to be evacuated due to a human or natural disaster. This agreement updates a prior agreement with Brownsburg Meadows. The agreement expires on June 30, 2027. In the agreement BCSC commits to provide sheltering space for up to 250 staff or residents at Brownsburg High School.

18. Approval of Special Use Agreements:

The Administration has approved the following Special Use Agreements:

Brownsburg Junior Soccer League: A Special Use Agreement dated August 25, 2022 and fully executed August 29, 2022, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, for the use of elementary and middle school gymnasiums, to be billed monthly at a rate of \$11.00 per hour. If additional custodial or maintenance services are required, these will be billed at a rate of \$40 per hour.

Girl Scouts of Central Indiana: A Special Use Agreement dated August 24, 2022 and fully executed August 29, 2022, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, for the use of elementary and middle school gymnasiums, cafeterias, media centers, and classrooms, to be billed monthly at a rate of \$11.00 per hour.

Brownsburg Little League Baseball: A Special Use Agreement dated August 24, 2022 and fully executed August 29, 2022, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, for the use of East and West Middle School baseball, softball, and auxiliary fields, at no cost. If additional custodial or maintenance services are required, these will be billed at a rate of \$40 per hour.

Brownsburg Swim Club: A Special Use Agreement dated August 19, 2022 and fully executed August 29, 2022, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, for the use of Brownsburg High School Pool and associated facilities, to be billed monthly at a rate of \$17.00 per hour for the pool, \$11.00 per hour for other spaces. Lifeguard fees will be charged at \$17.50 per hour for a regular lifeguard and \$20.50 per hour for a head lifeguard. If additional custodial or maintenance services are required, these will be billed at a rate of \$40 per hour.

Family Promise of Hendricks County, Inc.: A Special Use Agreement dated August 19, 2022 and fully executed August 29, 2022, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, for the use of Harris Academy Rooms 201, 201A, 201B, and 201C. An annual usage fee of \$2,080.00 is charged for this use. If additional custodial or maintenance services are required, these will be billed at a rate of \$40 per hour.

Brownsburg Lacrosse: A Special Use Agreement dated August 24, 2022 and fully executed August 29, 2022, for the 2022-23 lacrosse season, for the use of West Middle School Fields and the BHS Football Field. No use fee will be charged for use of open fields, while a fee will be charged of \$11.00 per hour of use for the West MS Football Field and \$88.00 hour of use for the BHS Football Field.

Brownsburg Boys Volleyball Club: A Special Use Agreement dated August 24, 2022 and fully executed September 2, 2022, for the school-year 2022-23 season, for the use of elementary, middle, and high school gymnasium space, to be billed monthly at a rate of \$11.00 per hour. If additional custodial or maintenance services are required, these will be billed at a rate of \$40 per hour.

Middle School 7th Grade Band and Choir and Orchestra – Out of State

The Brownsburg East and West Middle School 7th Grade Band, Choir and Orchestra students will be traveling to Kings Island, OH on Saturday, May 20, 2023. Approximately 346 students, 9 faculty chaperones as well as a yet to be determined number of approved parent chaperones will be traveling together. VII. OLD BUSINESS

A. Second Reading and Recommendation to Approve 2023 Board Meeting Schedule

Dr. Snapp recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the 2023 Board Meeting Schedule as presented for second reading.

Ms. Heffernan moved to approve the recommendation; Dr. Freije seconded the motion. The board approved the motion by a vote of five (5) ayes; zero (0) nays.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

A. Public Hearing on 2023 Budget

Mr. Hylton opened the public hearing at 6:48 p.m.

Mr. Hacker explained that this is the formal hearing in the budget process. He shared information on the FORM 3 which is the summary of the three major funds; Debt Service, Education and Operations. He noted the budget recommendation is always high to account for the authority to

spend. Mr. Hacker shared that we have still not received the assessed value for the year and that Friday will be the final ADM count. Mr. Hacker then shared the Bus Replacement plan which includes the purchase of 11 replacement buses. He also shared the Capital Projects plan which is an estimate of all projects throughout the corporation greater than \$10,000.

Mr. Hylton called for comments from the Board – there were none

Mr. Hylton called for comments from the public – there were none

Mr. Hylton closed the public hearing at 6:52 p.m.

B. Recommendation to Approve Anticipated Transfers between the Education Fund and the Operations Fund

Mr. Hacker recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the anticipated transfers of revenue from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund in the calendar year 2023, not to exceed \$6,000,000.

RESOLUTION FOR ANTICIPATED 2023 TRANSFERS BETWEEN THE EDUCATION FUND AND THE OPERATIONS FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees is the governing body of Brownsburg Community School Corporation, Hendricks County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, HB 1009 requires that distributions of tuition support be received in the Education Fund.

WHEREAS, HB 1009 required the governing body of each school corporation to establish an Education Fund for the payment of expenses allocated to student instruction and learning and an Operations Fund for the payment of expenses that are not allocated to student instruction and learning under IC 20-42.5.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of School Trustees gives the Treasurer of Brownsburg Community School Corporation the authority to make monthly transfers for a to be determined amount from the Education Fund to the Operations Fund not to exceed \$6,000,000 in total for the 2023 calendar year.

Dr. Freije moved to approve the recommendation; Ms. Heffernan seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of five (5) ayes; zero (0) nays.

C. Recommendation to Approve Transportation Levy Appeal

Mr. Hacker recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the recommendation to Approve the Excess Transportation Levy Appeal. Mr. Hacker explained that this appeal will assist in the additional costs associated with overall operating cost increases within the transportation department.

RESOLUTION FOR TRANSPORTATION LEVY APPEAL

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees of the Brownsburg Community School Corporation, Hendricks County, State of Indiana, has determined to file for an excess levy appeal; and

WHEREAS, the School Corporation requests and increase to its transportation fund maximum levy in the amount of \$1,500,000;

WHEREAS, the School Corporation seeks an increase to the transportation fund maximum levy pursuant to IC 20-46-4-10 due to transportation cost increases of at least ten percent (10%) over the preceding year;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of School Trustees hereby resolves to proceed with a petition for an excess levy to the Department of Local Government Finance;

Ms. Heffernan moved to approve the recommendation; Mrs. Dearman seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of five (5) ayes; zero (0) nays.

D. Recommendation to Approve Transfer of Real Estate

Mr. Hacker recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the resolution granting the transfer of real estate to Hendricks Power Cooperative for the purpose of a permanent 10' utility easement at Crossroads Elementary School. He explained this recommendation grants a utility easement for the main electrical services to the building.

RESOLUTION APPROVING EASEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS the Board of School Trustees (the "Board") of the Brownsburg Community School Corporation (the "School Corporation") reviewed and considered a Utility Easement and other related documents (collectively, the "Utility Easement Documents") attached hereto relating to the grant of an easement covering approximately 0.11 acres of land (the "Easement Property") from the School Corporation to Hendricks Power Cooperative ("HPC"); now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the Utility Easement Documents and the grant of the Easement Property to HPC in order to operate, install, maintain, replace, renew and remove an underground electrical service line; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School Corporation hereby approves the form of Utility Easement Documents presented to the Board and consents to the School Corporation's entrance into the Utility Easement Documents; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of the School Corporation hereby determines that the Easement Property is not needed for the use by the School Corporation; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that the Board of the School Corporation authorizes the execution of any and all documents relating to the grant of the Easement Property and the entrance into the Utility Easement Documents.

Mr. Wells moved to approve the recommendation; Mrs. Dearman seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of five (5) ayes; zero (0) nays.

E. Recommendation to Approve School Improvement Plans

Dr. Jessup recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the School Improvement Plans for the 2022-2023 school year. Dr. Jessup explained the improvement plans are very similar to what has been previously presented with the only changes being to the specific school goals based on the individual school data and student performance.

Ms. Heffernan moved to approve the recommendation; Mr. Wells seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of five (5) ayes; zero (0) nays.

IX. SUPERINTENDENT COMMENTS

Dr. Snapp thanked so many people for attending the meeting this evening. He shared it was great to commend Lincoln Klepper. Dr. Snapp offered special thanks to Chief Grimes and Chief Wing who did a great job of talking about the partnership between the two.

Dr. Snapp noted that Friday is the official count day and we expect to be up approximately 330 students. That is the largest growth in 20 years. So many families are choosing Brownsburg for the schools.

Dr. Snapp responded to the patron comment regarding transparency, offering his cell phone number to anyone who had any questions.

IX. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mrs. Dearman thanked everyone for coming. She appreciated the presentation by Chief Grimes and Chief Wing.

Dr. Freije thanked the police chiefs for all they do for the community. He noted it was nice to see so many in attendance at the meeting.

Ms. Heffernan thanked the police chiefs for keeping our kids safe.

Mr. Hylton shared that the board work session on August 24 was a retreat which is a public meeting. The Board attempts to have a retreat each year wear all five members are available for a longer period of time. It was scheduled at a time when all Board members were able to attend and provided a time for the Board to get together to do what’s good for the school corporation.

XV. ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Hylton called for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Wells moved for adjournment; Dr. Freije seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of five (5) ayes; zero (0) nays. The meeting adjourned at 6:59 p.m.
