<p><b>What</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Self Manager badge and privileges that go along with it (monthly school celebrations, in-class privileges as determined by individual teachers)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At the end of the week, two student names are drawn from each class bucket. Those students go to the office for a small prize.</li> <li>• At the end of the month, 10 student names are drawn from the school-wide bucket to receive a prize.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students who receive a ticket write their name on it and put it in the lunch ticket bucket at the end of lunch. One ticket per lunch is drawn. The person drawn is awarded by having lunch at the special table with a friend of choice from their lunch.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students fill out a Caught with Character and it is put in Ms. Barry's box. **Bucket Ticket**—It is expected that each staff member gives out a minimum of two Bucket Tickets per day. Students who receive a Bucket Ticket in class will place it in their class bucket. Students receiving a Bucket Ticket outside of class will be responsible for taking it to class, sharing it with the teacher, and placing it in their class bucket (exception—lunch bucket tickets go to the lunchroom buckets). At the end of the week, two student names will be drawn from each class and will go to the office to receive a small prize. Teachers may also offer additional incentives/rewards for Bucket Tickets. At the end of the week, classroom and lunchroom bucket tickets are tallied using the Bucket Ticket Tally Half-Sheet (this can be a student job; older students may also be trained to help Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade classrooms). All Bucket Tickets are then taken to the office and put into the School-Wide Bucket. The Bucket Ticket Tally Half-Sheet is given to Ms. Cordi. At the end of each month, 10 student names are drawn from the School-Wide Bucket to receive a prize.

**Caught with Character**—Students and staff may award these to anyone they see demonstrating a Pillar of Character. Completed awards are placed in Ms. Barry's box to be read over the announcements. Awards are then returned for students to take home.

**Project Character Awards**—These awards are given at bi-monthly assemblies. Recipients are determined by the classroom teacher, who may/may not include students in electing deserving recipients. Recipients receive a certificate and small prize at the assembly.

**BUG Awards**—Bring Up Grades (BUG) awards are given three times a year. Recipients are determined by the classroom teacher. Recipients receive a certificate and small prize at the assembly. At the end of the school year, Kiwanis provides a party for all BUG award recipients from the school year.

**Attendance Awards**—Attendance awards are given to students who attend 95% of the time. Awards can be earned per month. Students with 95% attendance in a month will be recognized at assemblies, and will be given a certificate to take home. Their names will be put on wall in the hallway.
