



ISB SCHOOL BUS SERVICE PROVIDED BY LOCAL MOTION

2023-2024 ROUTES AND SCHEDULE

As of 6/30/2023

Transportation Service will be provided Monday through Friday in accordance with the [ISB 2023-2024 school calendar](#) during the period **starting on Thursday, August 31, 2023 and ending on Friday, June 14, 2024.**

We are offering two routes *(the stops will be officially released later in August 2023):*

- Route #1: Mattapan - Boston (JP/South End/Back Bay) - Charlestown - ISB
- Route #2: Newton - Waltham - Lexington - Arlington - Belmont - ISB

Bus information:

- ★ Children aged 4/entering Mid-K and up may ride the bus
- ★ School bus 47 passenger
- ★ Seat belts
- ★ GPS ([instructions](#))
- ★ The bus arrives at ISB at 7:45 a.m. and departs ISB at 3:30 p.m.
To avoid holding the buses back, we kindly ask Middle and Upper School students to hurry to their bus directly after dismissal at 3:25 p.m.
- ★ 2023-2024 rates (the bus service is substantially subsidized by the School):

Transportation service	1 student	2 siblings or more
Round-trip	\$4,950 per student	\$3,960 per student
One-way	\$2,475 per student	\$1,980 per student

- Fees will be invoiced when the Student Transportation Agreement & Registration form is duly completed and emailed back to [me](#).
- Payment is due upon receipt of the invoice and before the service starts.

You will be required to sign up for the bus service on a first-come first-served basis with the understanding that overall priority will be given, in order of priority, to returning students, students coming from Boston or Belmont/Lexington, siblings and elementary school students. Also required is a commitment to ride the bus for the full year and full payment upon signing a contract for service. We will not be able to reimburse for service lost to short or medium term closure, either of the entire school or of a cohort, cohorts or individual child due to exposure to or infection with COVID-19. Our contract with Local Motion stipulates full payment for the entire school year, regardless of closure. This is an effort on Local Motion's part to preserve business continuity by having the means to maintain their buses and pay their drivers. The drivers are the crucial component: it is they who ensure the safe delivery of your children to school and home daily. Partial reimbursement would only occur in the case of closure at any point during the school year for the remainder of the school year.
