

SCHOOL PHYSICAL AND IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

O'Fallon Township High School District 203

The following information explains the State of Illinois health requirements for the 2022-2023 school year.

- Health Record Forms should be turned into the school by the first day of attendance.
- Failure to turn in the physical and immunization records will exclude your student from school attendance as of October 15.

FRESHMAN AND NEW STUDENTS

- A Completed physical Examination on the State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination Form dated within one year of the start of school is required. That form can be found at: <https://dph.illinois.gov/content/dam/soi/en/web/idph/files/forms/certificate-of-child-health-examination-03032017.pdf>

The top of the freshman and new students' physical exam form looks like the image below. This physical also meets the sports physical requirement.

IMMUNIZATIONS: To be completed by health care provider. The mo/da/yr for <i>every</i> dose administered is required. If a specific vaccine is medically contraindicated, a separate written statement must be attached by the health care provider responsible for completing the health examination explaining the medical reason for the contraindication.						

NOTE: The IHSA sports physical form (image below in the “Athletes” section) does NOT meet the entering freshman or new student to the district physical requirement.

- Complete immunization record. Confirm this information with your medical provider.
- Dental Exam (due May 15). The form for the dental exam is: <https://dph.illinois.gov/content/dam/soi/en/web/idph/files/forms/dental-exam-form-2021.pdf>
- Eye exam if new to the state of Illinois
- Forms for physicals, immunizations, eye and dental exams must be turned into the nurse's office. It is highly recommended you keep a copy for your personal records.

SENIORS

- Two doses of meningococcal vaccine with one dose received at 16 years of age or older. If the first dose was received at 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required.

ATHLETES

You must have your sports physical turned in prior to try outs or the first practice. You can find the form at the link below. This form does not meet the freshman or new student physical requirement. You can submit the State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination (see image above) as a sports physical.
