Whereas, profound economic and technical changes in our society are rapidly reflected in the structure and nature of work, thereby placing new and additional responsibilities on our educational system; and



Whereas, career and technical education has taken on new meaning in our district with the advent of RC3; and


Whereas, our CTE programs provide students with opportunities to gain invaluable hands-on experiences through internships, apprenticeships, and cooperative education programs; and
